DECLARATION FOR INVALID PENSION.

Act of June 27, 1890.

Note.—This can be executed before any officer authorized to administer oaths for general purposes. If such officer uses a seal, certificate of clerk of court is not necessary. If no seal is used, then such certificate must be attached.

STATE OF MARYLAND, CITY OF BALTIMORE, ss:

On this 9 day of August in year one thousand eight hundred and ninety nine, personally appeared before me, a JUSTICE OF THE PEACE within and for the City and State aforesaid Elby Rosier aged 59 years, a resident of the City of BALTIMORE, State of MARYLAND, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical

Elby Rosier, who was ENROLLED on day of January 1864, in Co. G. 9 Regt. U. S. A. (Here state rank, company, and regiment if in the Army; vessel, if in the Navy).

in the service of the United States in the war of the rebellion, and served at least ninety days, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Baltimore, Md. on the day of December 1866

That he is unable to earn a support by manual labor by reason of rheumatism (Here name the disease or

heart disease, failure of sight, disease of lungs, injuries from which disabled, injury to left ankle, misery in breast, shortness of breath and general debility. The least excitement increases him and gives him palpitation of the heart.

That said disabilities are not due to his vicious habits, and are to the best of his knowledge and belief of a permanent character. That he has applied for pension under application No. That he was

was a pensioner under Certificate No. 624,582 (If a pensioner, the certificate number only need be given.

If not, give the number of the former application, if one was made).

That he has never been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above.

That he make this declaration for the purpose of being on the pension-roll of the United States, under the provisions of the act of June 27, 1890. He hereby appoints

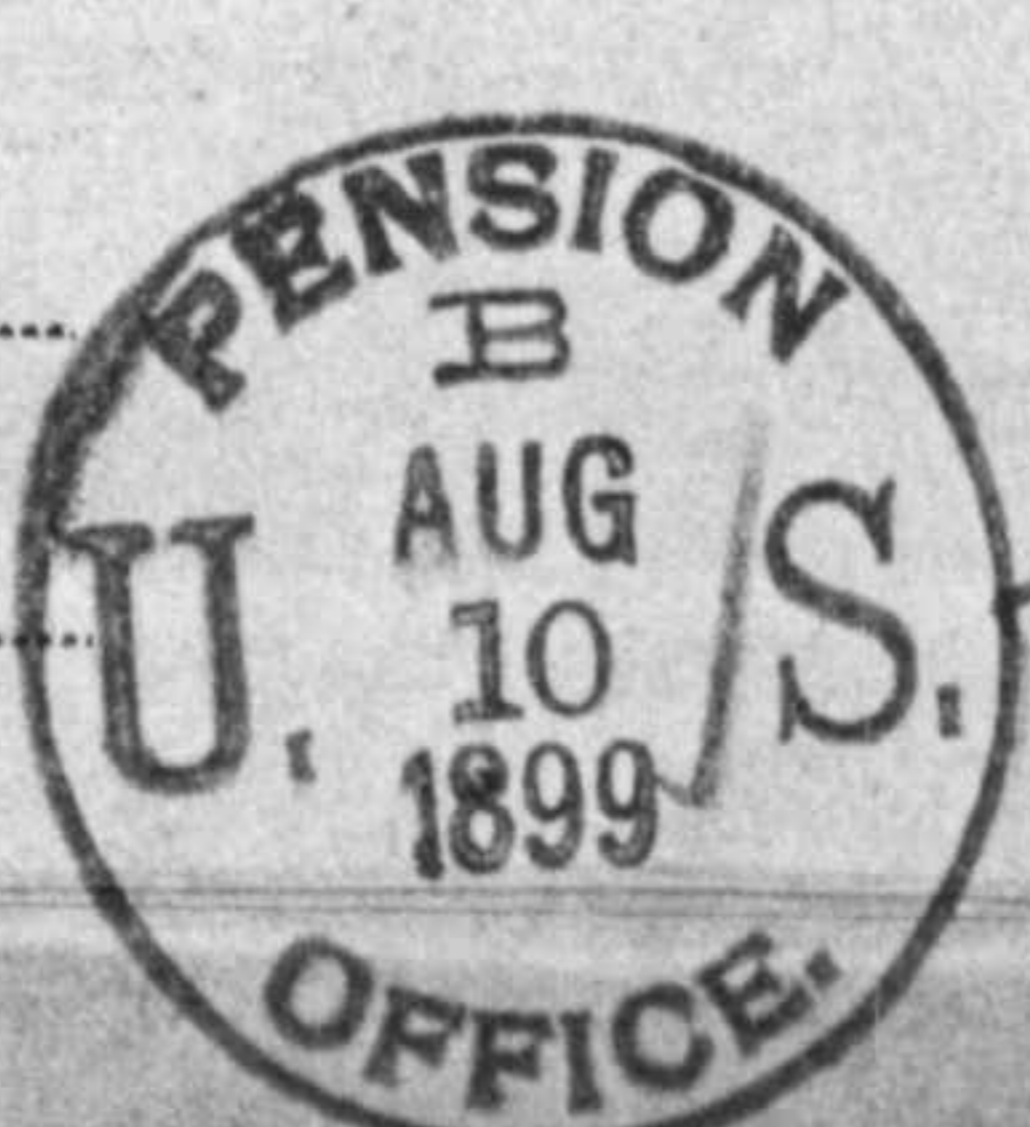
