I am not willing to accept age as alleged or even age 70 as established.

The Soldier, Claimant, was 20 years old at enrollment, corroborated by age of parent at discharge, thus indicating that he is now 68 years of age, or born August 2, 1843, if we give him the benefit of the month's pay alleged. He has increased in stature 3 or 4 inches since enlistment.
