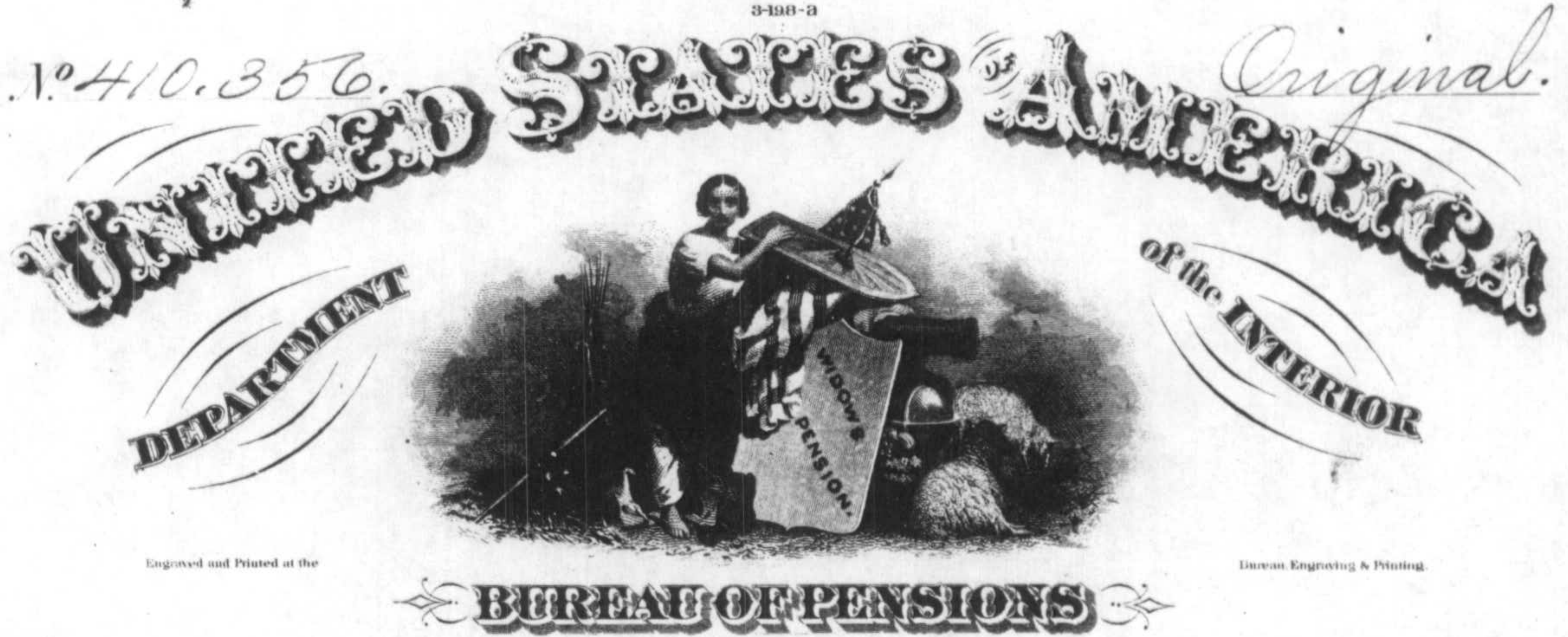

ACT OF JUNE 27, 1890.



It is hereby certified That, in conformity with the laws
of the United States Rebecca Ennolds
Widow of James Ennolds who was
a Private, Co. G, 39th Regiment, United States Colored Volunteer Infantry,
is entitled to a pension under the provisions of the
Act of June 27, 1890.
at the rate of Eight dollars per month, to commence on the
Eighteenth day of July 1893, and to continue
during her widowhood.

and of the Independence of the United States
