She is insane and has the so called since she was 9 years old when she was taken with Epilepsy followed by insanity. She requires constant aid and attention, and can do no work. Her name is Catherine Enolds, when she was born I was attended by colored woman in Sugar Alley, ^{Chick St.} long since dead. She was a regular midwife but I have forgotten her name.

Catherine was born in the summer - in July or August, I think. I know it was very warm weather but I cannot give the date. I cannot read or write and have a very poor memory now. Yes, Catherine was christened at Home when she was 3 or 4 months old. The minister who christened her was Rev. Wesley Brown, now dead of Jew Wesley, or Sharp St. A. M. E. Church. I have had the Church books examined but Catherine's name could not be found. I also went to the City Hall to see if there was a record of the birth but none was found.
