Q. Did he not have this cough prior to his
 being wounded?
 A. No sir. I am positive he did not. I was with
 acquainted with him from the time of his return
 and I know that he was a very bold and hearty
 man up to the time of his fight at Fort Johnson
 I don't believe he showed a shemunk cough
 of his right up to the time he was wounded.

 afterwards?
 A. He was a very steady soldier when at the time
 I know him and my religious and conscientious
 I know him the character of his habits and
