The Regt was stationed July 1 to 4, 64, on board Steamer "Canonius"; July 5, landed at James Island, S.C.; July 8, landed at Johns Island; July, 12th Holly Island; July 14, Hilton Head; July 16, Jacksonville, Fla; July 22, left Jacksonville, on expedition to Baldwin, Fla; July 23, in the field, Fla; July 27, arrived at Baldwin, Fla, and remained there to July 31, 64.
