

Declaration for an Original Invalid Pension.

This must be Executed before a Court of Record or some Officer thereof having Custody of the Seal.

State of Maryland, County of Baltimore, ss:

ON THIS 27 day of June, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety,

personally appeared before me Deputy Clerk of the Superior Court a Court of Record within and for the County and State aforesaid

aged 44 years, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical John Armstrong who was ENROLLED as a private on the 1 day of

March, 1864, in Company B of the 39 regiment of U.S.C.T. commanded by Capt. Lombardy and was honorably DISCHARGED

Baltimore, Md. on the 25 day of Dec., 1865. That his

personal description is as follows: Age 14 years; height 5 feet 4 inches; complexion brn. hair black; eyes black.

That while a member of the organization aforesaid, in the service and in the line of duty at Fort Liberty at Olden Railway, Va. in the State of Va. on or about the Summer day of 1864 he contracted weakness

(Here state the name or nature of disease, or the location of wound or injury. If disabled by disease, state fully its cause; if by wound or injury, the precise manner in which received.)
A back from camp's knees and back had to be cupped.

That he was treated in hospitals as follows: General Hospital, Wilmington, N.C., Feb, 1864
(Here state the names or numbers, and the localities of all hospitals in which treated, and the dates of treatment.)

That he has not been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above (Here state what the service was, whether prior or subsequent to that stated above and the dates at which it began and ended.)

That he has not been in the military or naval service of the United States since the 1st day of Sept, 1865.

That since leaving the service this applicant has resided in the City of Baltimore in the State of Md. and that his occupation has been that of a laborer.

That prior to his entry into the service above-named he was a man of good, sound, physical health, being when enrolled a man.

That he is now partially disabled from obtaining his subsistence by manual labor by reason of his injuries, above described, received in the service of the United States; and he therefore makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the invalid pension roll of the United States. He hereby appoints with full power of substitution and revocation,
