Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate, 80; respiration, 19; temperature, N; height, 5 feet 8 inches; weight, 176 pounds; age, 48 years. General physical condition good.

There is no evidence of rheumatism except slight sensitiveness over the crest of the left ilium and right ankle with pain when manipulating the joint. No deformity of the joints.

Heart and Lungs are normal.

Liver, Stomach and Spleen in healthy condition.

We cannot find any cause for the dyspnoea from which he claims to suffer.

Rectum: Anus is patulous. Rectal walls relaxed with tendency to prolapse. States that he has protrusion at times. No hemorrhoids.

Eyes are normal in appearance. Vision good for age.

No other disability exists.
