 31 back after this time when I saw  
 32 him, but he had been living in  
 33 Dorchester County Md after his re-  
 34 turn from the army. No, I don't  
 35 know of my personal knowledge  
 36 whether he lived with my mother  
 37 in Dorchester County after his re-  
 38 turn from the army. He never  
 39 lived with her after she moved  
 40 to Baltimore. I have no personal  
 41 knowledge of my father having  
 42 a wife after the war in Dorchester  
 43 county by the name of Harriet -  
 44 Harriet Pritchett - but I heard  
 45 him speak of her. He said  
 46 she died down there. He finally  
 47 moved to Baltimore but not  
 48 until after a time when he said  
 49 that Harriet had died.

50 After he came to Baltimore he  
 51 is said to have married a woman  
 52 by the name of Eliza Rich. I did  
 53 not see them married but I  
 54 know that he used to live with  
 55 her. I used to visit him while  
 56 he was living with her. I first  
 57 remember them living on Winter St  
 58 between Ray and Walker Alley, then  
 59 on Peach alley, then on Howard St.  
 60 near Hamburg. She died while  
 61 they were living on Howard St.
