 33 his marriage to either of these women.
 34 Yes, I remarried after I left
 35 Robert Barnes. When Mary Frances
 36 was about 16 years old (1878 or 79) and
 37 when George H was 6 or 7 years old, I
 38 married a man named Isaac Handy.
 39 I was married to him by Rev. Fitzhugh
 40 a Methodist Minister. We had licenses.
 41 He was a sailor, mostly on oyster
 42 boats. After I had been living with
 43 him for about three years his mother,
 44 now dead, came to Baltimore and
 45 told me that he had another wife
 46 living on Deals Island, Md. She said
 47 he had grown children by the other
 48 wife. When I first heard this I
 49 asked him about it and he denied
 50 it. I lived with him perhaps a
 51 year after I heard about this
 52 other wife then he went away
 53 and didn't show up any more.
 54 I never heard from him after
 55 he left. About three years
 56 ago or more I heard that
 57 he was dead. No, I don't know
 58 which way he went after he
 59 left me. He was a kind of
 60 Methodist preacher.
