DECLARATION FOR WIDOW'S PENSION, ACT

To be executed before a Court of Record or some officer thereof having custody of its seal, a Notary Public, or Justice of the Peace, whose official signature shall be verified by his official seal, and in case he has none, his signature and official character shall be certified by a Clerk of a Court of Record, or a City or County Clerk.

State of Maryland, County of Baltimore, SS:

On this 9 day of Sept, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and 16, personally appeared before me, a Notary Public, within and for the County and State aforesaid, Jane Jordan, aged 60 years, a resident of Baltimore, County of Baltimore, State of Maryland, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that she is the widow of James Jordan, who enlisted under the name of James Jordan, in Company G, 30th Regt of U.S. Transferred to Navy, and served at least ninety days in the late War of the Rebellion, in the service of the United States, who was HONORABLY DISCHARGED.

That he was employed in the military or naval service of the United States after the date stated above, and the dates at which it began and ended.

That she was married under the name of Jane Jordan on the 13 day of June, 1860, by Rev. Frank Johnson, at Baltimore, Md., there being no legal barrier to such marriage; that she had not been previously married; that her said husband had not been previously married. (4)

That she has not remarried since the death of the said James Jordan.

That she has not abandoned the support of any one of her children, but that they are still under her care or maintenance. That prior application for pension has been filed by herself or the soldier (A or no.) James Jordan, pension July 6, 1877 # 767776.

That she makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension-roll of the United States, under the provisions of the act of April 19, 1908. She hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation, Lloyd Odendahl, of Baltimore, MD, to prosecute her claim, the fee to be Ten Dollars, payable as prescribed by law.

That her post-office address is, 1643 Vincent St, Baltimore, State of Maryland, County of Baltimore.
