

June 27 1890's Declaration for Pension or Increase of Pension.

This must be Executed before a Court of Record or some Officer thereof having Custody of the Seal.

State of Maryland, City of Baltimore, ss:

ON THIS 30 day of June A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety

personally appeared before me a Poppy Clark of the Superior Ct a Court of Record within and for the County and State aforesaid Rosetta Wells

aged 49 years, who, being duly sworn according to law, makes the following declaration in order to obtain

the Pension provided by Acts of Congress granting pension to widows: That she is the widow of Wm

Wells, who enlisted under the name of Wm Wells

at Baltimore, on the day of Fall A. D. 1863

in Co B 19th U. S. C. I. & Drues pension

by Cert No 186109 (Company and Regiment of service, if in the army; or vessel and rank, if in the navy.)

in the war of 1861-1865 who that he served for

more than ninety days during war 1861-5 or the disease and manner in which it was incurred, in either case showing soldier's death to have been the sequence.)

(2) that he was honorably discharged (3) who died of

apoplexy of head the day of 27 June 1890

that this claimant is without other means of support other than her daily labor who bore at the time of his death the rank of

that she was married under the name of Rosetta Johnson to said

Wm Wells on the day of August 6 or 7 years before War

Rev Mr Merritt at Queenstown there being no legal barrier to such marriage; that neither she nor her husband had been previously married

(If either have been previously married so state, and give date of death or divorce of former spouse.)

that she has to present date remained his widow; that the following are the names and dates of birth of all his legitimate children yet surviving who were under sixteen years of age at father's death, viz:

That she has not abandoned the support of any one of her children, but that they are still under her care or maintenance.

(For such children as are not under her care claimant should account.)

that she has not in any manner engaged in, or aided or abetted the rebellion in the United States; that

prior application has been filed by soldier granted

by Cert No 186109 that she hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation,

A. Parlee Lloyd of Baltimore, Md,

her attorney to prosecute the above claim that her residence is No 609 Perie
