DECLARATION FOR ORIGINAL INVALID PENSION.

TO BE EXECUTED BEFORE A COURT OF RECORD OR SOME OFFICER THEREOF HAVING CUSTODY OF ITS SEAL:

On this 2nd day of November, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and eighty-Nine personally appeared before me, Clerk of the Circuit Court, a court of record within and for the County and State aforesaid, Peter Johnson aged 67 years, a resident of the Town of Unionville, county of Talbot State of Maryland, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares

that he is the identical Peter Johnson who was ENROLLED on the 23rd day of September, 1863, in Company A of the 7th Regiment of U. S. Colored Troops commanded by Charles S Rice capt and was honorably DISCHARGED at Madanala on the 13th day of October, 1864; that his personal description is as follows: Age, 41 years; height 5 feet 6 inches; complexion, Black; hair, Black; eyes, Black

That while a member of the organization aforesaid, in the service and in the line of his duty at Darbytown Road, in the State of Virginia on or about the 28th day of October, 1864, he While engaged in a skirmish with the enemy was received a gun shot wound in the left hand which wound has resulted in Rheumatism or Neuralgia in the left hand and arm

Here state name or nature of disease, or the location of wound or injury. If disabled by disease, state fully its causes; if by wound or injury, the precise manner in which received.

That he was treated in hospitals as follows: at Fortress Monroe, Virginia for said wound where he remained nearly 3 three months about the 1st of November 1864

Here state the names or numbers, and the localities of all hospitals in which treated, and the dates of treatment.

That he has not been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above Here state what the service was, whether prior or subsequent to that stated above, and the dates at which it began and ended.

That since leaving the service this applicant has resided in the County of Talbot in the State of Maryland, and his occupation has been that of a Laborer. That prior to his entry into the service above named he was a man of good, sound, physical health, being when enrolled a Laborer. That he is now partially disabled from obtaining his subsistence by manual labor by reason of his injuries, above described, received in the service of the United States; and he therefore makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the invalid pension roll of the United States.

He hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation, Guy Plumb and Geo. Washington J. C. his true and lawful attorney to prosecute his claim. That he has not received or applied for a Pension. That his POST OFFICE ADDRESS is Easton county of Talbot State of Maryland.
