of the soldier's debts - but as nearly as I can remember the amount of debts brought against the estate together with the work exp. referred to above amounted to about \$450 -

I have filed the account with the Orphans Court.

Q What if any debts do you own?

A I borrowed \$75.00 from Irving Mason of Cambridge Md. for current expenses - and I still owe it. At the time of the soldier's death the only personal property - outside of household goods he owned was 2 horses - worth about \$100, and 2 cows worth about \$25,

I have sold one cow since for \$13.

Q What has been your income since your husband's death?

A The only means of support I have had since the soldier's death has been the accrued pension due the soldier - and the amount received from the land.

My oldest son lives in the other place - and after paying fertilizer bill and a down interest we got about \$400 from the wheat crop.

We had 78 bushels of wheat - but Widby Harris as a down (\$15) interest in the place - and of the balance my son gave me what he did not absolutely need.

There was 11 ^{at \$1.50 a bbl.} bbls of corn and 9 baskets - but we sold none of that - used it between us and have it enough to last until next season. Corn and wheat were the only crops we raised there last year.

On this lot we raised 9 bbls of long and short corn - most of the place being in pasture.
