Private Thomas Woolford, of 1st Chas S Bjornmark Company, (19) of the 7th Col'd Troop Regiment of the United States Army, was enlisted by Col W. Burney of the \_\_\_\_\_ Regiment of \_\_\_\_\_ at Baltimore Md on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1863, to serve 3 years; he was born in Dorchester Co in the State of Maryland, is Twenty one years of age, 5 feet \_\_\_\_\_ inches high, Briff complexion, Black eyes, Curly hair, and by occupation when enlisted a Farmer. During the last two months said soldier has been unfit for duty 00 days.\*
