In the matter of pension claim of Horace Gibson
late a private of Co B 7th regt United States Colored Troops
on this 30th day of August 1890 personally appeared before
me a Justice of the Peace in and for aforesaid
County duly Authorized to Administer Oaths
John Gleason age 47 years a resident of Longwood Talbot County
Md and whose post office is Longwood Talbot County Md
And William Gleason age 51 years a resident of Talbot
County Md and whose post office is Easton Md Both well
known to me to be respectable and entitled to credit
and who being duly sworn declare in relation
to the aforesaid case as follows: that we have been
well and personally acquainted with Horace Gibson
the claimant "each one of us respectively 40 years
and a comrade of his in the late war of rebellion in
Co B the 7th regt United States Colored Troops and
was present at the time when Soldier Horace Gibson
Received his injury which is ruptured on
the right side the Soldier inform us at the time
that he had received an injury from lifting
we was building winter quarter at Benedict
Charles County Md some time late in the fall 1863
I cant remember the date of the month: ¹⁸⁶⁸
but I remember the place and what we were
doing when the claimant inform us that he had
Received his injury - he inform us of his
