~~No~~ A Justice of the Peace must not authenticate this paper. If he does, the work is utterly useless, and must be all done over again before a Judge or Clerk of a Court of Record, as above stated.

ON THIS Eighteenth day of April A. D. one thousand eight hundred and sixty June, personally appeared before me, (1) Clerk of the (2) Princetown Court, a Court of Record within and for the County and State aforesaid, Princetown Darby, aged years, a resident of the (3) City of Baltimore, in the State of Maryland, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical Princetown Darby who (4) Volunteered in the service of the United States at Camp Bidger, Baltimore City Md in the State of Maryland, on or about the September day of September, in the year 1863, as a Corporal in Company C commanded by Capt. Wm. C. Batt, in the 75 Regiment of (5) Col. Col. of Troops commanded by Col. Batt, in the war of 1861, and was honorably discharged at M.C. Knob's Hospital Baltimore City in the State of Maryland, on or about the January day of January, in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty Sixty; that while in the service aforesaid, and in the line of his duty, (6) b7

At the Battle of Fort Gilmer on the 29 Sept.
1864 he was wounded in the right arm
by a Minie Ball causing a painful wound

Also at the same time and place he had the thumb
on his right hand, carried away by a Minie Ball
He now is greatly disabled from earning his
livelihood from his former employment, that of
Harnessing, - besides refined work that pays any
thing, and is in need of a pension,

That since leaving the said service, this applicant has resided in the (3) County of Green Anne's near Indentown, in the State of Maryland, and his occupation has been (7) Fight
Harnessing.

That prior to his entry into the service above named, he was a man of good, sound physical health, being when enrolled, a (8) Farmer

That now he is (9) disabled from obtaining his subsistence from manual labor in consequence of his above named injuries, received in the service of the United States.

He makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the Invalid Pension Roll of the United States, by reason of the disabilities above stated, and revoking and countermanding all other authority that may have been given, he hereby constitutes and appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation,

No 56 Mr. Fayette St. of (3) Baltimore Md, his true and lawful attorney, to prosecute his claim, and obtain the Pension Certificate that may be issued. That his Post Office is at No 110 Chestnut Alley County of Baltimore State of Maryland. That his domicile or place of abode is (10) No 110 Chestnut Alley, Baltimore City, Md.
