

DECLARATION FOR AN INVALID PENSION.

This Invalid Pension Declaration must be executed before a Judge or Clerk of a Court of Record, and if before the Judge, the Clerk thereof will certify said Judge's official capacity and signature, and attest the same under the seal of the Court.

A Justice of the Peace must not authenticate this paper. If he does, the work is utterly useless, and must be all done over again before a Judge or Clerk of a Court of Record, as above stated.

ON THIS Eighth day of April A. D. one thousand eight hundred and sixty June, personally appeared before me, (1) Clerk of the (2) Superior Court, a Court of Record within and for the County and State aforesaid, Princest-Denby, aged years, a resident of the (3) City of Baltimore, in the State of Maryland, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical Princest-Denby who (4) Volunteered in the service of the United States at Camp Red Bank, Baltimore City Md in the State of Maryland, on or about the day of September in the year 1863, as a Corporal in Company C commanded by Capt. Wise in the 7th Regiment of (5) Inf. Cold Troops commanded by Col. Pratt in the war of 1861, and was honorably discharged at McKim's Hospital Baltimore City in the State of Maryland, on or about the day of January in the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty Six; that while in the service aforesaid, and in the line of his duty, (6).....

At the Battle of Fort Gilmore on the 29th Sept 1864 he was wounded in the right arm by a Minnie Ball causing a painful wound
Also at the same time and place he had the thumb on his right hand, carried away by a Minnie Ball
He now is greatly disabled from obtaining his livelihood from his former employment, that of Farming - he is refused work that pays any thing and is in need of a Pension

That since leaving the said service, this applicant has resided in the (3) County of Queen Anne's near Lidentown, in the State of Maryland, and his occupation has been (7) Fight Farming

That prior to his entry into the service above named, he was a man of good, sound physical health, being when enrolled, a (8) Farmer

That now he is (9)..... disabled from obtaining his subsistence from manual labor in consequence of his above named injuries, received in the service of the United States.

He makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the Invalid Pension Roll of the United States, by reason of the disabilities above stated, and revoking and countermanding all other authority that may have been given, he hereby constitutes and appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation,.....

No 56 Mr. Clayton H. of (3) Baltimore Md, his true and lawful attorney, to prosecute his claim, and obtain the Pension Certificate that may be issued. That his Post Office is at No 100 Chestnut Alley County of Baltimore State of Maryland. That his domicile or place of abode is (10) No 100 Chestnut Alley, Baltimore City, Md.
