

Declaration for an Original Invalid Pension.

This must be Executed before a Court of Record or some Officer thereof having Custody of the Seal.

State of Maryland, County of Baltimore, ss:

ON THIS 31 day of May A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety

personally appeared before me a Deputy Clerk of the Deputy Clerk a Court of Record within and for the County and State aforesaid Alexander Russum,

aged 47 years, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical

Alexander Russum, who was ENROLLED as a private on the 23 day of September, 1863, in Company B of the 7 regiment of U.S.C.

commanded by Capt. Ferguson and was honorably DISCHARGED at Indianola, Texas, on the 13 day of October, 1864; That his

personal description is as follows: Age 21 years; height 5 feet 7 1/2 inches; complexion black hair curly; eyes black.

That while a member of the organization aforesaid, in the service and in the line of duty at Indianola in the State of Texas,

on or about the — day of April, 1864, he contracted

rheumatism in the legs with great pain
(Here state the name or nature of disease, or the location of wound or injury. If disabled by disease, state fully its cause; if by wound or injury, the precise manner in which received.)

and swelling.

That he was treated in hospitals as follows: By regimental surgeon

That he has — been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above
(Here state what the service was, whether prior or subsequent to that stated above and the dates at which it began and ended.)

That he has not been in the military or naval service of the United States since the — day of October, 1866

That since leaving the service this applicant has resided in the City of Baltimore, in the State of Maryland, and that his occupation has been that of a laborer.

That prior to his entry into the service above-named he was a man of good, sound, physical health, being when enrolled a family. That he is now three-fourths disabled

from obtaining his subsistence by manual labor by reason of his injuries, above described, received in the service of the United States; and he therefore makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the invalid pension roll of the United States. He hereby appoints with full power of substitution and revocation,
