

June 25, 1891, alleges injury to right shoulder,
 rheumatism, disease of throat and lungs,
 affection of leg, head and eyes and vertigo,
 rejected Sept. 1, 1892. Declaration filed Sept.
 26, 1892, alleges injury to right shoulder, rheu-
 matism, disease of lungs, legs and eye, vertigo,
 general disability, dyspepsia and blindness;
 affidavit filed Oct. 6, 1892, alleges affection of
 head and eyes and vertigo, attributed by
 claimant to sun-stroke; declaration filed
 July 23, 1896, alleges rheumatism, injury to
 right shoulder, affection of legs and disease of
 heart, eyes and throat; rejected Nov. 12, 1896.
 Declaration filed May 11, 1897, alleges weak-
 ness of both legs, the result of bone fever,
 rheumatism, throat and chest disease, af-
 fection of sight and injury to right shoul-
 der from puncture by a needle; rejected
 Oct. 13, 1898. Pending Declaration filed
 Feb. 16, 1900, alleges rheumatism, weakness
 in legs from bone fever, bad eyesight,
 injury to right shoulder from being stuck
 with a needle, bronchitis and kidney
 trouble.
