DECLARATION FOR PENSION.

THE PENSION CERTIFICATE SHOULD NOT BE FORWARDED WITH THE APPLICATION.

State of Maryland, County of Calvert, ss:

On this 26 day of August, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and 12, personally appeared before me, a Justice of Peace within and for the county and State aforesaid, Alexander Burrum, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is 70 years of age, and a resident of United States county of Calvert

State of Maryland; and that he is the identical person who was ENROLLED at Pumpkin Bellefonte, under the name of Alexander Burrum on the 26 day of September, 1863 as a Private in Company B. Iowa Regiment Colored Troops

(Here state rank, and company and regiment in the Army, or vessels if in the Navy.) in the service of the United States, in the Civil War war, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Baltimore, on the 13th day of October, 1866. That he also served None (Here give a complete statement of all other services, if any.)

That he was not employed in the military or naval service of the United States otherwise than as stated above. That his personal description at enlistment was as follows: Height, 5 feet 9 inches; complexion, Chestnut; color of eyes, Dark; color of hair, Black; that his occupation was Farmer; that he was born August 26th, 1842, at St. Alberts Court In State of Maryland

That his several places of residence since leaving the service have been as follows: Baltimore 38 years In Calvert County one year (State date of each change, as nearly as possible.)

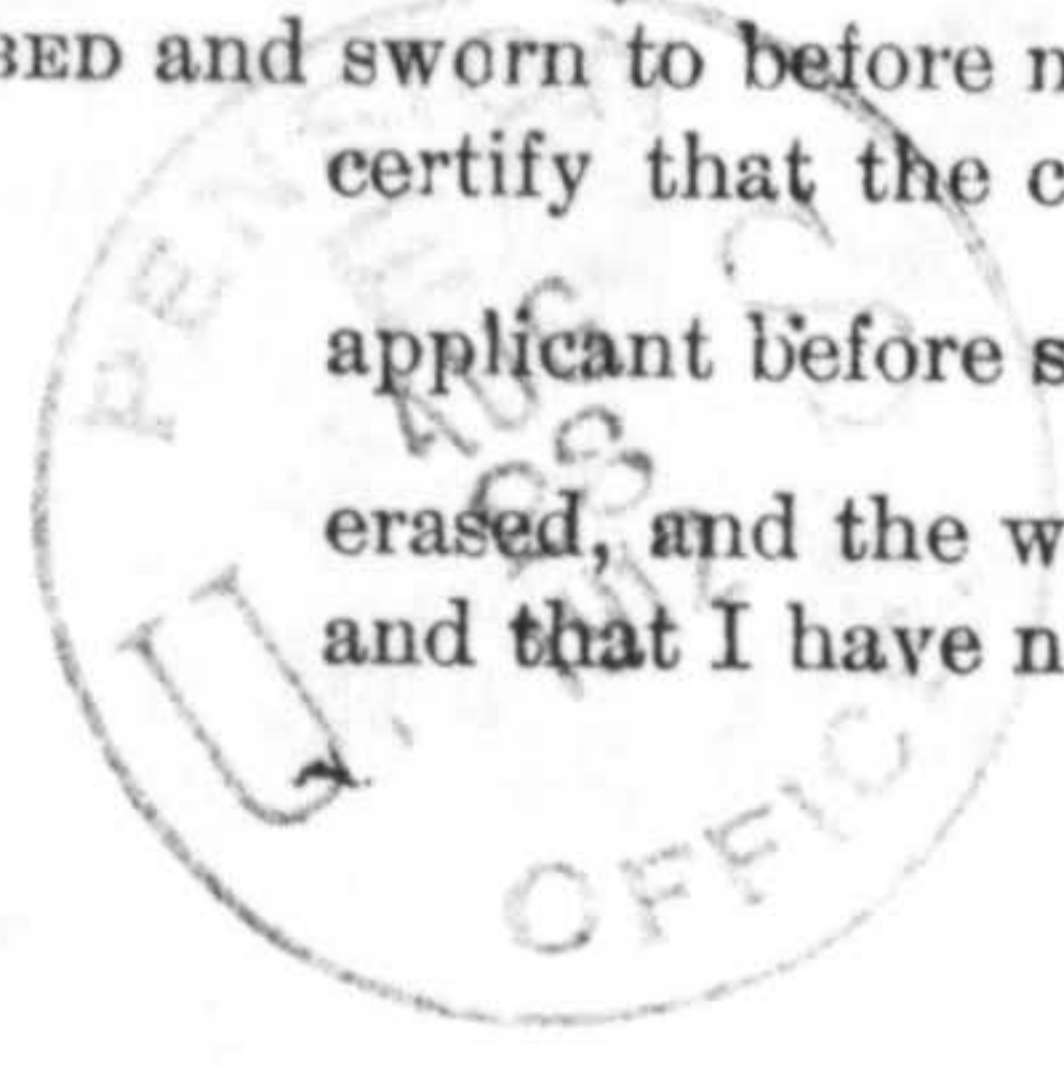
That he is a pensioner under certificate No. 1006689. That he has applied for pension under original No. 1006689.

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the provisions of the act of May 11, 1912.

That his post-office address is St. Leonard, county of Calvert, State of Maryland.
