DECLARATION FOR PENSION.

THE PENSION CERTIFICATE SHOULD NOT BE FORWARDED WITH THE APPLICATION.

On this 11th day of January, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and eleven, personally appeared before me, a Notary Public within and for the county and State aforesaid, William Johnson, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is 72 3/4 years of age, and a resident of Milford county of Kent, State of Delaware; and that he is the identical person who was ENROLLED at Chestertown Maryland under the name of William Johnson, on the 2nd day of May, 1863 as a private, in Company E, 7th Md. Volt. U.S. Colored Troops.

in the service of the United States, in the Civil war, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Baltimore Md, on the 2nd day of October, 1865. That he also served in the army or navy of the United States before about May 1863 or after about October 1865. He was wounded in left foot, and also in the breast. That he was not employed in the military or naval service of the United States otherwise than as stated above. That his personal description at enlistment was as follows: Height, 5 feet 3 inches; complexion, Dark; color of eyes, D. Bro.; color of hair, Black; that his occupation was Farm Hand; that he was born March 22, 1838, at Queen Anne Co. Ind.

That his several places of residence since leaving the service have been as follows: Kent Co - Md 2 years - New Castle Co - Delaware - 9 years to 1876 then in Chest. Penn, until 1883. then in Phila, till 1884 and in Maple shade N. J. - until July 1910 - and in Milford, Del. since

That he is not a pensioner. That he has heretofore applied for pension claim No. 1323292.

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the provisions of the act of February 6, 1907.

That his post-office address is 401 Fruit Ave. Milford, county of Kent, State of Delaware. William Johnson (Claimant's signature in full.)

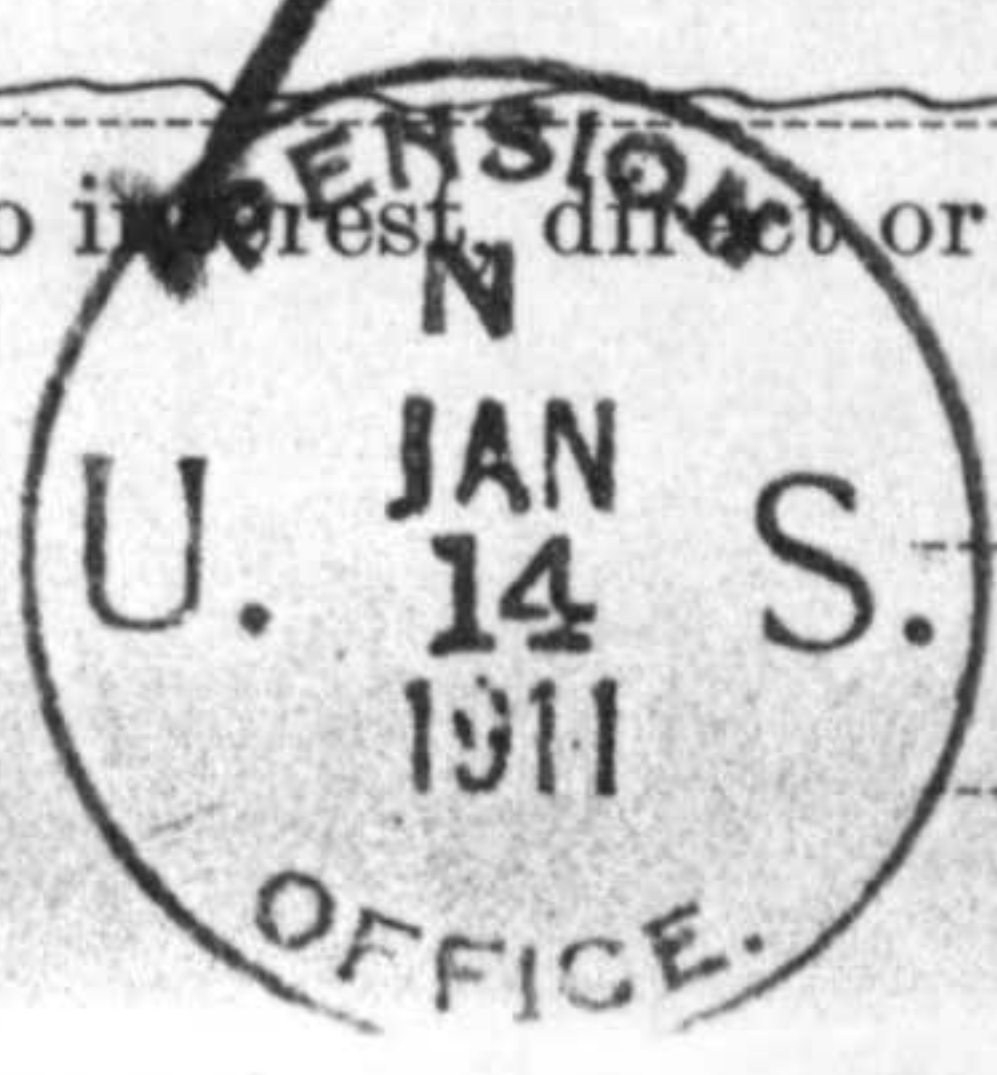
