

# DECLARATION FOR PENSION.

THE PENSION CERTIFICATE SHOULD NOT BE FORWARDED WITH THE APPLICATION.

On this 11<sup>th</sup> day of June, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and Eight personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace within and for the county and State aforesaid, William Johnson, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is 69 years of age, and a resident of Camden county of Camden, State of New Jersey; and that he is the identical person who was ENROLLED at Baltimore Md. under the name of William Johnson, on the May day of 1865, as a private; in Co E. 7<sup>th</sup> Regt. N. S. A.

in the service of the United States, in the Civil war, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Greenston Pa., on the October day of 1865.
