DECLARATION FOR PENSION.

THE PENSION CERTIFICATE SHOULD NOT BE FORWARDED WITH THE APPLICATION.

On this 21st day of May, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and Eight, personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace within and for the county and State aforesaid, William C. Johnson, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is 69 years of age, and a resident of Camden county of Camden, State of New Jersey; and that he is the identical person who was ENROLLED at Chestertown Md under the name of William C Johnson, on the day of May, 1863 as a Private, in Company E, 7th Regiment Md Col, Inf, U. S. C. S. (Here state rank, and company and regiment in the Army, or vessels if in the Navy.) in the service of the United States, in the Civil war, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Brownsville Texas, on the day of October, 1865. That he also served (Here give a complete statement of all other services, if any.)

That he was not employed in the military or naval service of the United States otherwise than as stated above. That his personal description at enlistment was as follows: Height, 5 feet 3 1/2 inches; complexion, Black; color of eyes, Black; color of hair, Black; that his occupation was Lawn Hand; that he was born March 2nd, 1839, at Quaker Neck Kent County Md

That his several places of residence since leaving the service have been as follows: Chestertown Md. Head of Sarface Md. Middel Town Del New Castel Del Wilmington Del Old Chesto Pa Phila Pa Camden N.J. (State date of each change, as nearly as possible.)

That he is a pensioner. That he has heretofore applied for pension The number of his claim is 1323292 act of June 27 1890 (If a pensioner, the certificate number only need be given. If not, give the number of the former application, if one was made.)

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the provisions of the act of February 6, 1907.

That his post-office address is 1400 Broadway Camden, county of Camden, State of New Jersey

Johnson, the claimant, sign his name (or make his mark) to the foregoing declaration; that they have every reason to believe, from the appearance of the claimant and their acquaintance with him of 3 years and 10 years, respectively, that he is the identical person he represents himself to be, and that they have no interest in the prosecution of this claim.
