Sir:

In response to your attached call of 16th instant, received today, you are advised that your call of the 1st inst. was on form 120 with initials and numbers, as follows:- "DAC 320 JHP 336006", and referred to the applicant and post-office address based upon the service of William Johnson, Co. E, 7th U.S.C. Inf. The Bureau's reply of the 12th instant is erroneous. The records of this Bureau fail to show that any claim was ever filed based upon service of William Johnson, Co. E, 7th U.S.C. Inf., but a claim was filed by William C. Johnson, as stated in former letter, which claim stands rejected on the ground that report from records of the War Department do not show name of such soldier in the organization named, nor on the rolls of any company of the regiment. One William H. Johnson was granted pension under Ctf. No. 592238, based upon service in said Company and Regiment, and if you desire abstract of testimony in that case please renew your call.
