To the Commissioner of Pension

Dear Sir I write to you

in my case for Pension, the number of claim is 013 895, My husband died July 21, 1913, about a month after his death I made an application for a Pension, an account of the soldier death whose name was Robert Bennett who drew a Pension of 40 dollars a month, he had one leg off the number of his certificate is no 50.154. the case of Wounded Pension is in the hands of David L. Stenton 10428 N. Pea Street Baltimore Md for Prosecution the trouble in my case is that I cannot get any positive evidence for the death of my first husband William Williams who died in Boyview asylum Baltimore Md, who died July 6 1881, there seem to be no record of his death there we have tried to find it, but have failed, Robert Bennett my last husband was married to Lydia my wife I met him, but she died in November 1877 I have got all the evidence call for about her except the exact date and the witness cannot remember the date of the month she died I could get several more witnesses of her death who saw her after death but none of them can recollect the exact date of her death
