

DECLARATION FOR WIDOW'S PENSION.

State of Maryland, County of Dorchester ss:

On this 16 day of Sept, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and 18 personally appeared before me, a Justice of The Peace within and for the county and state aforesaid Lenna Bennett aged 65 years a resident of Cambridge, County of Dorchester, State of Maryland, who, being duly sworn according to law, makes the following declaration in order to obtain pension under the provisions of the Act of Congress Approved, April 19, 1908.

That she is the widow of Robert Bennett, who was Enrolled under the name of Robert Bennett, at Baltimore Md, on the 20 day of September 1863 as a Private in Co D 7 Regt United States Colored Troops Here state rank, and company and regiment, in the Army, or vessels, if in the Navy. and honorably discharged 17th Day of May, 1865, having served ninety days or more during the late civil war.

That he also served (Here give a complete statement of all other services if any.)

That he was not in the military or naval service of the United States otherwise than as stated above

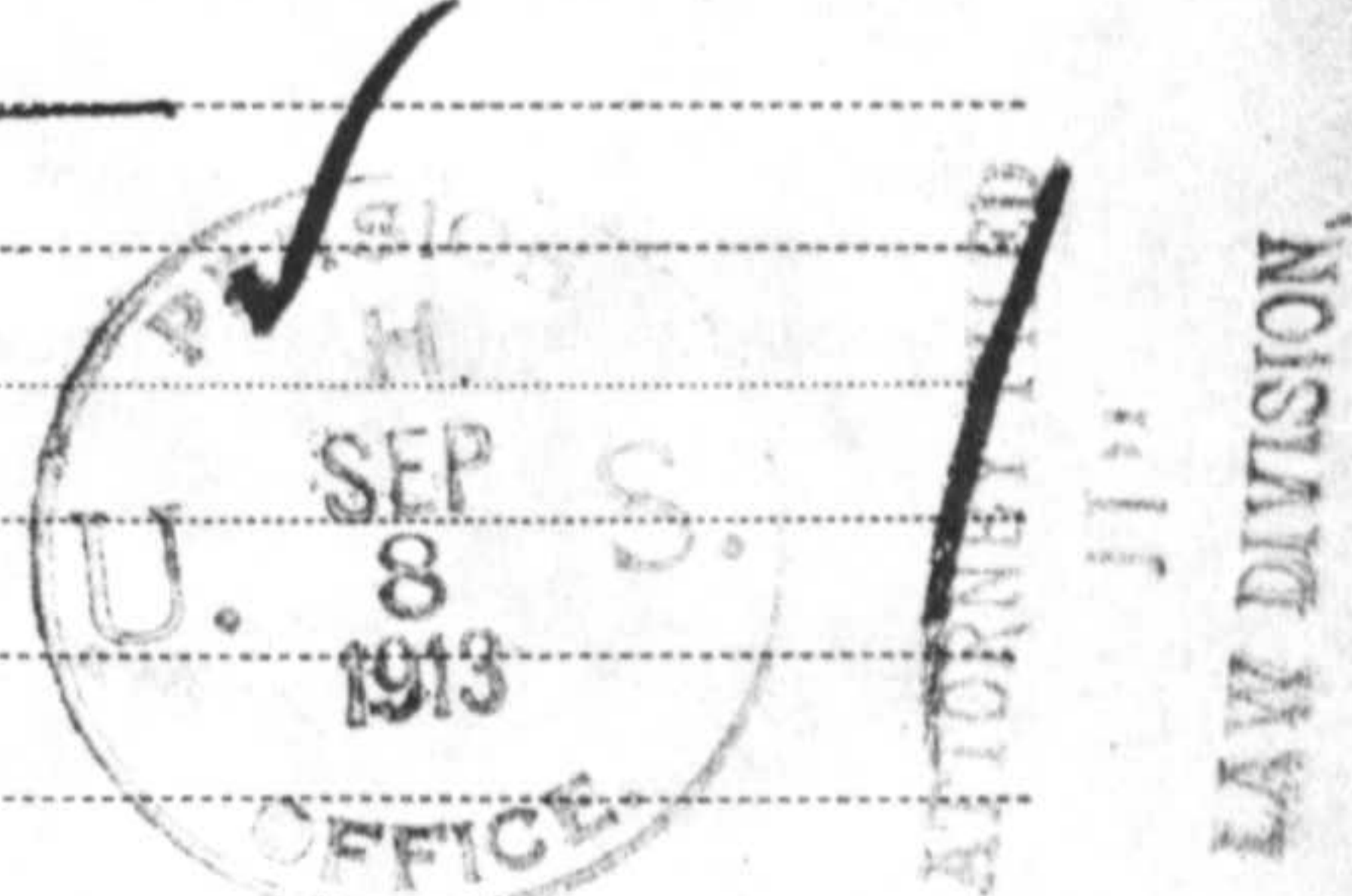
That she was married under the name of Lenna Williams to said soldier at Cambridge Md on the 21 day of October, 1885 by Rev Mr Thomas; that there was no legal barrier to the marriage, that she had been previously married; that the soldier had been previously married.

She had been married to William Williams who died July 4 1881, Robert Bennetts 1st wife died in November 1877 (If there was a prior marriage of either, the date and place of death or divorce of former consort or consorts should be stated.)

and that neither she nor said soldier married otherwise than is stated above That the said soldier died 21st July, 1919, at Cambridge Md that she was not divorced from him, and that she has not remarried since his death.

That the said soldier left the following-named children who are now living and under sixteen years of age, to wit: (If the soldier left no children, the claimant should so state.)
