

DECLARATION FOR ORIGINAL INVALID PENSION.

TO BE EXECUTED BEFORE A COURT OF RECORD OR SOME OFFICER THEREOF HAVING CUSTODY OF ITS SEAL.

personally appeared before me, Deputy Clerk, Circuit Court No. 2, a court of
record within and for the County and State aforesaid, Edward Borham aged
42 years, a resident of 210 Richmond Street, county of Baltimore

State of Maryland, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares
that he is the identical Edward Borham who was ENROLLED on
the September day of 1863, in Company "A" of the 7 Regiment
of U.S.C Troops commanded by Capt. Rice
and was honorably DISCHARGED at Baltimore City, Md on the _____ day
of _____, 1866; that his personal description is as follows: Age, 42 years; height
5 feet 6 inches; complexion, dark; hair, black; eyes, dark brown

That while a member of the organization aforesaid, in the service and in the line of his duty at Powder
horn, in the State of Texas on or about the _____ day
of _____, 1865, he While assisting in unloading
Here state name or nature of disease, or the location of wound or injury. If disabled by
disease, state fully its causes; if by wound or injury, the precise manner in which received.
a vessel at Powder horn Texas. he wrenched
his ankle (left) causing a severe sprain from

date March 1890

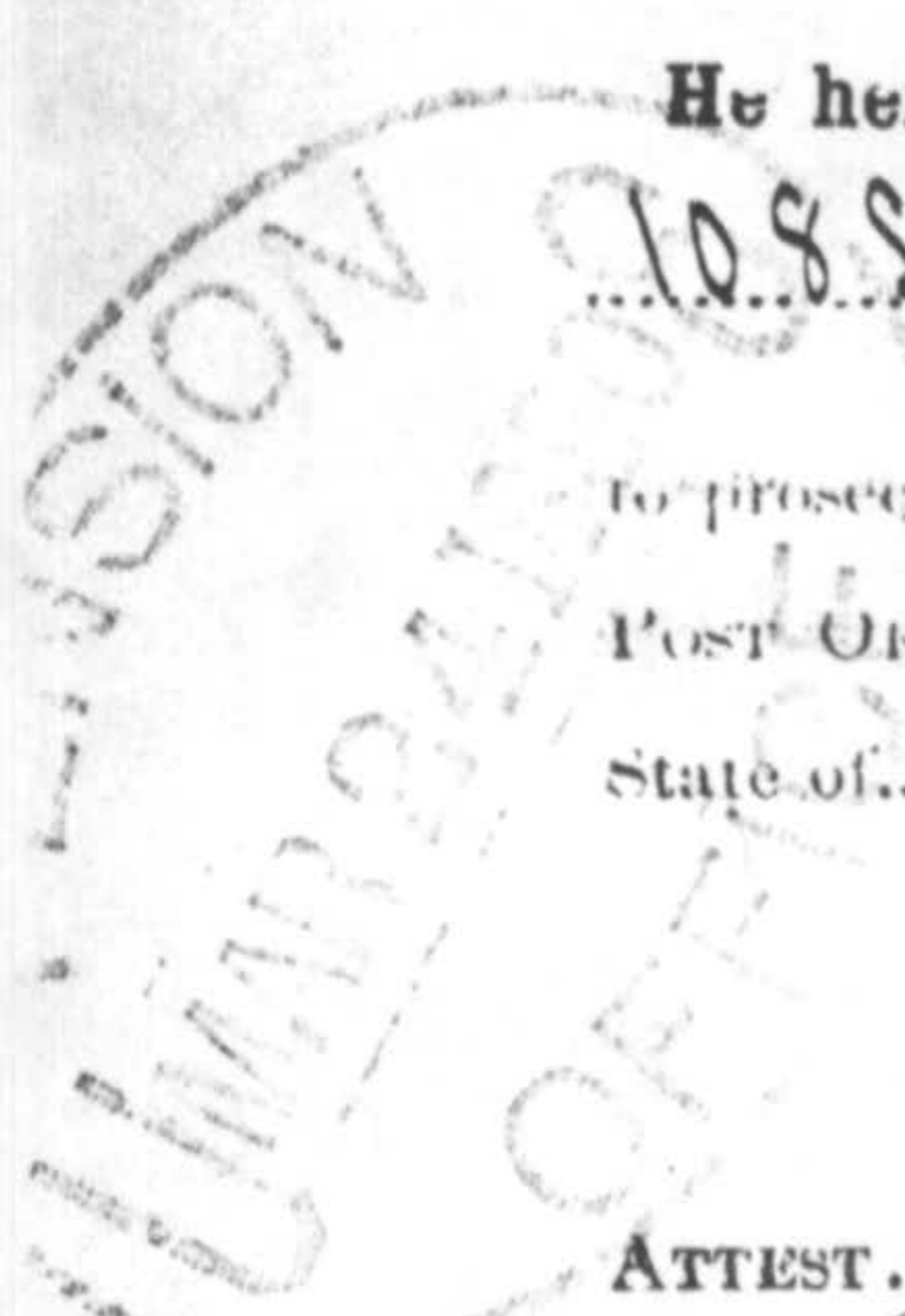
That he was treated in hospitals as follows: At Powder horn Texas

That he has not been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above

That prior to his entry into the service above named he was a man of good, sound, physical health, being when
enrolled a waiter. That he is now partially disabled from obtaining his subsistence by
manual labor by reason of his injuries, above described, received in the service of the United States; and he there-
fore makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the invalid pension roll of the United States.
