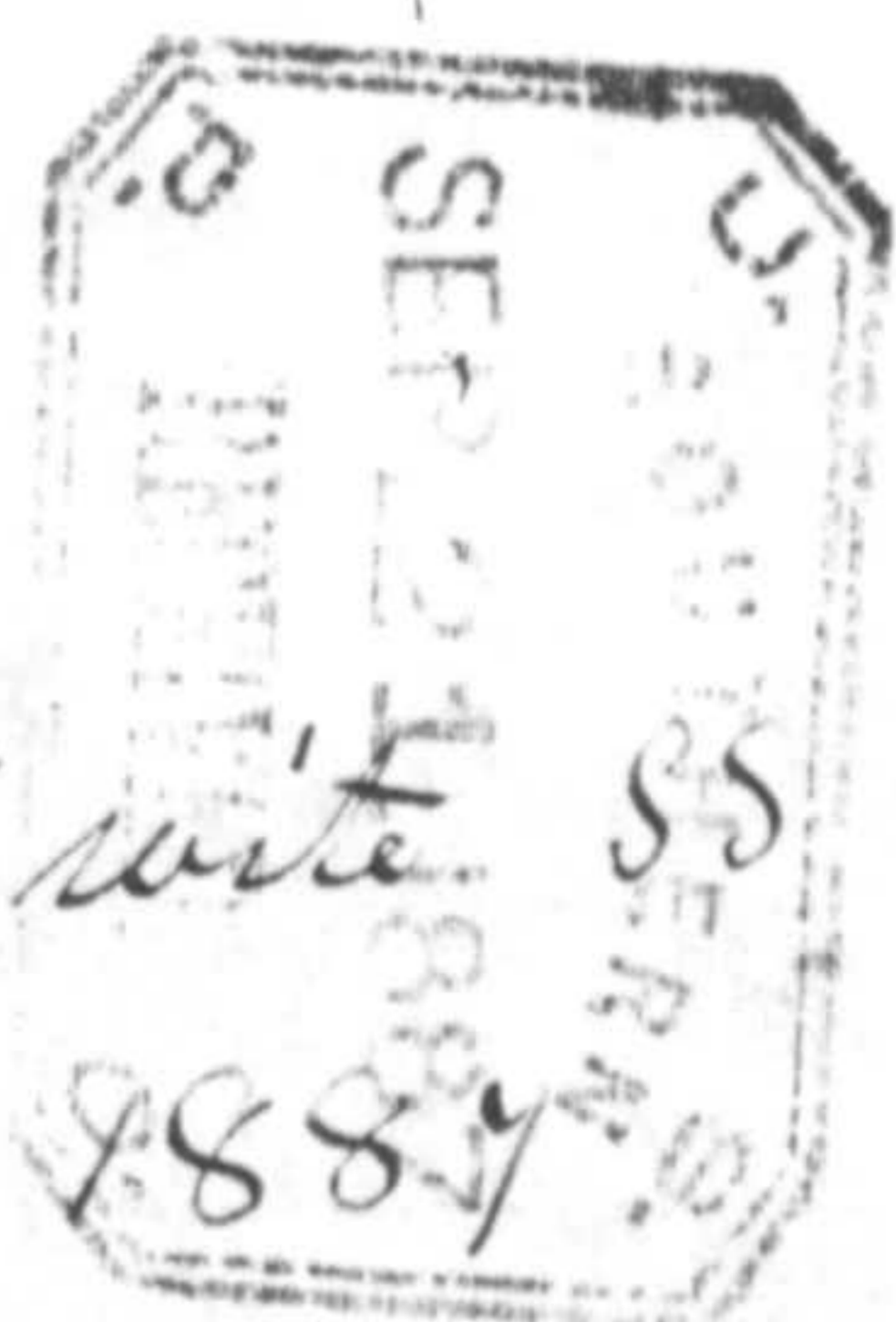


A general affidavit



State of Maryland County of Talbot to wit: SS
 on this 10th day of September in the year of 1887
 personally appeared before me a Justice of the peace
 in and for the aforesaid County and State Ernold
 Measey age 48 year's a resident of Talbot County
 State of Maryland and Joseph Johnson age 46 year's
 A resident of Talbot County State of Maryland - and being
 Citizen's of this County and State of Maryland - and of full
 age - well known to me to be reputable and entitled to
 Credit. and who being by me duly sworn - declares
 each, in relation to the aforesaid pension claim No
 150,030 of Sarah Sale - the widow of Joseph Sale
 deceased - who ^{was} a private in Co B. of the 7th regiment
 U.S.C.I. As follow's - we were well acquainted with
 Joseph Sale in his lifetime - and that Joseph Sale
 was a able bodied man at the date of his enlistment
 being that of a laborer - and that to our knowledge
 the said Joseph Sale become disabled in the
 lines of duty - the first injury that was received
 was from retreating down the rail road to
~~from~~ Jacksonville from Bowling Fla - in
 1864 this injury was in the ankle - the same
 ankle was injured againe by a tree limb falling
 on it. While in the woods - near deep Bottom
 in the state of Va - in the same year of 1864
 the said Joseph Sale become Lame in the said ankle
 we have any knowledge of Joseph Sale being taken
 to any Hospital from the regiment or Co. 1)
