DECLARATION FOR WIDOW'S PENSION.

This can be Executed before a Notary Public, a Justice of the Peace, or a Court of Record.

State of Maryland County of Talbot ss:

On this 29th day of July, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety-
personally appeared before me, a clerk of the Circuit Court
within and for the county and State aforesaid, Mrs Sarah Gale
aged 55 years, a resident of the Tunis of Miles River Neck County
of Talbot, State of Maryland who, being duly sworn according
to law, declares that she is the widow of Joseph Gale, who enlisted under the
name of Joseph Gale, at Baltimore Md on the 13th
day of November, A. D. 1863, in B the 7th regt U.S. C. I
Here state rank, company and regiment, if in military service, or United States Army

and served at least ninety days in the late **War of the Rebellion**, who was **Honorably Discharged**
Baltimore Md, and died at Miles River, in the State of Md,
on or about the 11th day of March, 1894. That she was married under
the name of Sarah Johnson to said Joseph Gale
on the day of , 18 , by Rev Dr. Henry Mason,
at Easton Maryland, there being no legal barrier to said marriage.
