Official Signature The act of June 27, 1890, requires, in case of a Soldier: An honoroble discharge. An minimum service of ninety days. Permanent disability not due to his vicious habits, which need not have originated in the service. The rates under the act are graded from \$6 to \$12, proportioned to the degree of inability to carn a support. The rates are not affected by the rank held. A pensioner under prior laws may apply under this one, or a pensioner under this one may apply under any other laws, but cannot draw more than one pension for the same period.
