We hereby certify that in compliance with the requirements of the law we have carefully examined this applicant who states that he is suffering from the following disability, incurred in the service, viz: G S W of left leg Rheumatism

He makes the following statement upon which he bases his claim for Inc [Original, increase, restoration, &c.]

Here give the claimant's statement as briefly and as compactly as possible.

Examined by Dover Board seven or eight years ago G S W of left leg for which he is pensioned is about the same as when last examined but he has rheumatism - Curdley. The latter that is rheumatism came on 7 years ago lasting one week in bed since then he has had 3 attacks lasting one to 2 weeks has rheumatism in elbows and knees. Lost 1/3 of his time from the performance of manual labor.

Here give a full description of the disability, in accordance with pars. 6, 8, 51, 52, &c., of Book of Instructions for 1889

Upon examination we find the following objective conditions: Pulse rate, 90 respiration, 18; temperature, 98 2/5; height, 5 feet 8 inches; weight, 165 pounds; age, 40 years. G S W of left leg Ball entered on inner side of leg six inches below internal condyle of femur. Removed at point of entrance Cic measures 1/2 x 3/4 inches not adherent tender loss of tissue or injury to bone Legs of uniform size both above and below knees Tongue furred Pharynx normal Skin and conjunctiva normal Sight and hearing normal Stomach Bowel Rectum Liver and spleen normal Heart nervous frequent Apex impulse in 6th intercostal space in median line Hypertrophied with extension in area of percussion Dullness but no intermission regurgitation murmurs or valvular lesions Lungs normal Respiration clear distinct and resonant No dullness upon percussion Lung expansion 3 1/2 inches. Rheumatism Cephalic and stiffness in both elbows and both knees but no swelling enlargement inflammation or impaired mobility. The claimant has marked Curdley as his rheumatism is double the cause of his heart trouble. All unmentioned organs joints muscles and tendons healthy.

Rate for EACH cause of disability.

He is, in our opinion, entitled to a rating for the disability caused by G S W of left leg 4/8 for that caused by rheumatism, and 4/8 for that caused by
