

DECLARATION FOR ORIGINAL PENSION OF A WIDOW ~~CHILD OR CHILDREN~~  
UNDER SIXTEEN YEARS OF AGE SURVIVING.

State of Maryland  
County of Baltimore } ss:

On this 4 day of February, A. D. one thousand Nine hundred and fourteen, personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace within and for the County and State aforesaid, Sarah V. Riley, (Name of claimant.) aged 56 years, a resident of Centerville Maryland (Give City, Village, or Town, County, and State; if you reside in a city where streets are named and houses are numbered, give name of street and number of house. If you reside in the country, state about how many miles from nearest Postoffice.) who, being duly sworn according to law, makes the following declaration in order to obtain the pension provided by Act of Congress granting pensions to widows, approved July 14, 1862, and supplemental acts amendatory thereof, to wit:

That she is the widow of Robert Riley, (Name of soldier or sailor) who served during the late War of the Rebellion under the name of Robert Riley (Name under which he enlisted) from the 23 day of September, A. D. 1863, to the 13 day of October, A. D. 1866, as a private in Co. B, 7 Regt. M.S.C. Inf (Give rank.) (State company and regiment, or other organization, if in the Army; or name of vessel and his rank, if in the Navy.) and who was HONORABLY DISCHARGED from the service Texas, 13 day of October 1866, (Give date and place of discharge.) and who died of \_\_\_\_\_ (Give cause of death.)

on the 24 day of December, A. D. 1913, at Crownsville Queen Anne Co Md (State place of death, if known.) that she was married under the name of Sarah V. Glover (Name before marriage to said soldier.) to said Robert Riley (Name of soldier.) on the 23 day of February, A. D. 1868, by Rev David H. Harris (Name of clergyman or other person officiating.)

at Corsica Neck, Queen Co, Md (Place of marriage.) there being no legal barrier to such marriage; that neither she nor her husband had been previously married husband dissolved by divorce (If either have been previously married, so state, and give date of death or divorce of former spouse.) Soldier by Death

that she has not remarried since the death of the said Robert Riley; that the following are the names and dates of birth of all his legitimate children WHO WERE UNDER SIXTEEN YEARS OF AGE at the date of the soldier's death:

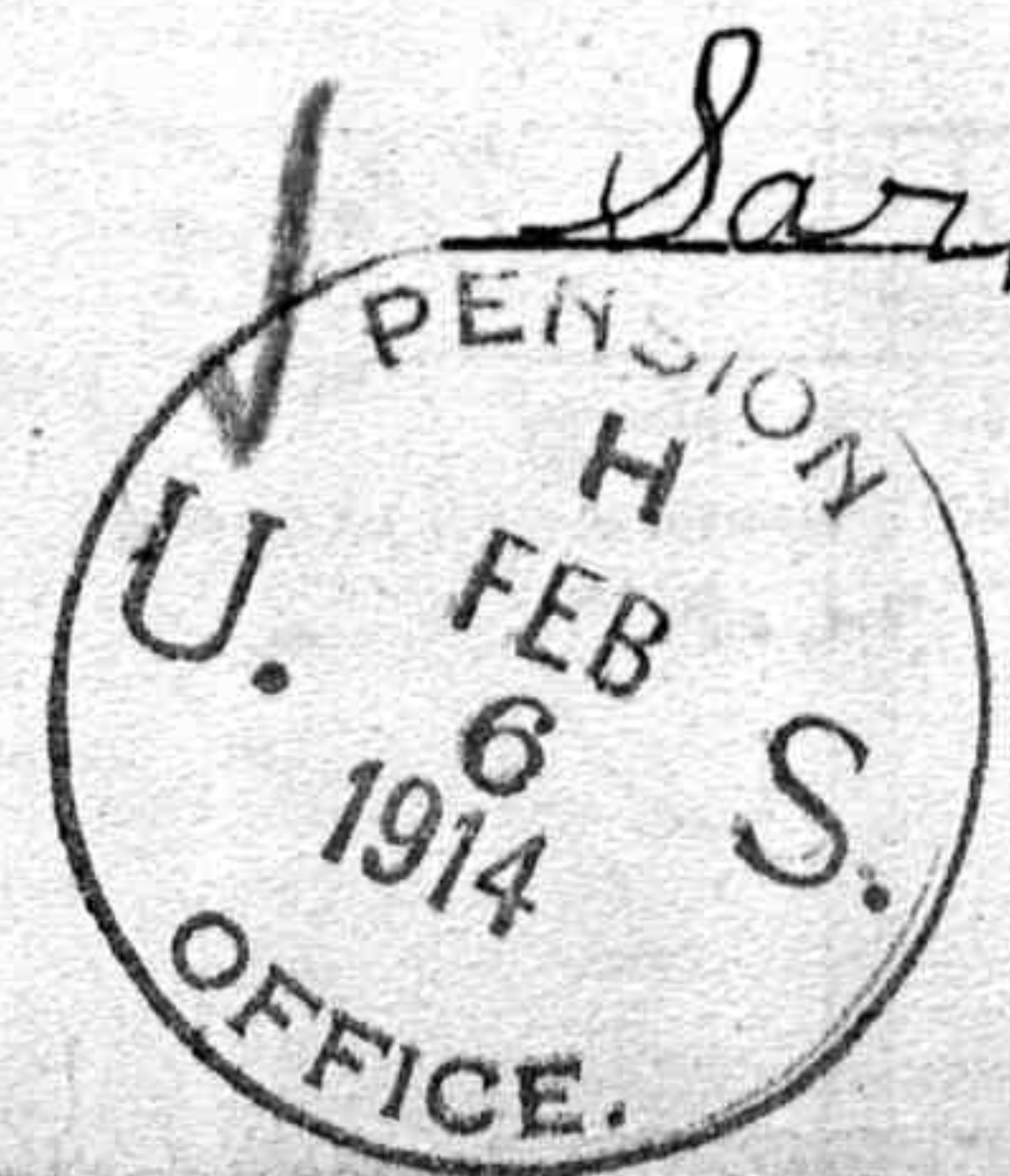
