DECLARATION FOR PENSION.

THE PENSION CERTIFICATE SHOULD NOT BE FORWARDED WITH THE APPLICATION.

State of Maryland, County of Kent, ss:

On this 22 day of March, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and fifteen, personally appeared before me, a Notary Public, Alexander Chaney, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is 45 years of age, and a resident of Chestertown, county of Kent, State of Maryland;

and that he is the identical person who was ENROLLED at Chestertown Kent Co Maryland, under the name of Alexander Chaney on the 20 day of November, 1864 as a Private, in Co D 6 Reg U S Colored Inf Shipanitz (Here state rank, and company and regiment in the Army or vessels if in the Navy.)

in the service of the United States, in the Civil war, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED (State name of war, Civil or Mexican.)

at Shelton Hills, Pa. on the 20 day of September, 1865.

That he also served Exhibited a Record from The War Department Which Shows He Was 25 years old When Discharged (Here give a complete statement of all other services, if any.)

That he was not employed in the military or naval service of the United States otherwise than as stated above. That his personal description at enlistment was as follows: Height, 5 feet 9 inches; complexion, Dark; color of eyes, Dark; color of hair, Dark; that his occupation was Laborer; that he was born March 1th, 1839, at War Millington Kent Co Maryland

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the provisions of the act of May 11, 1912.

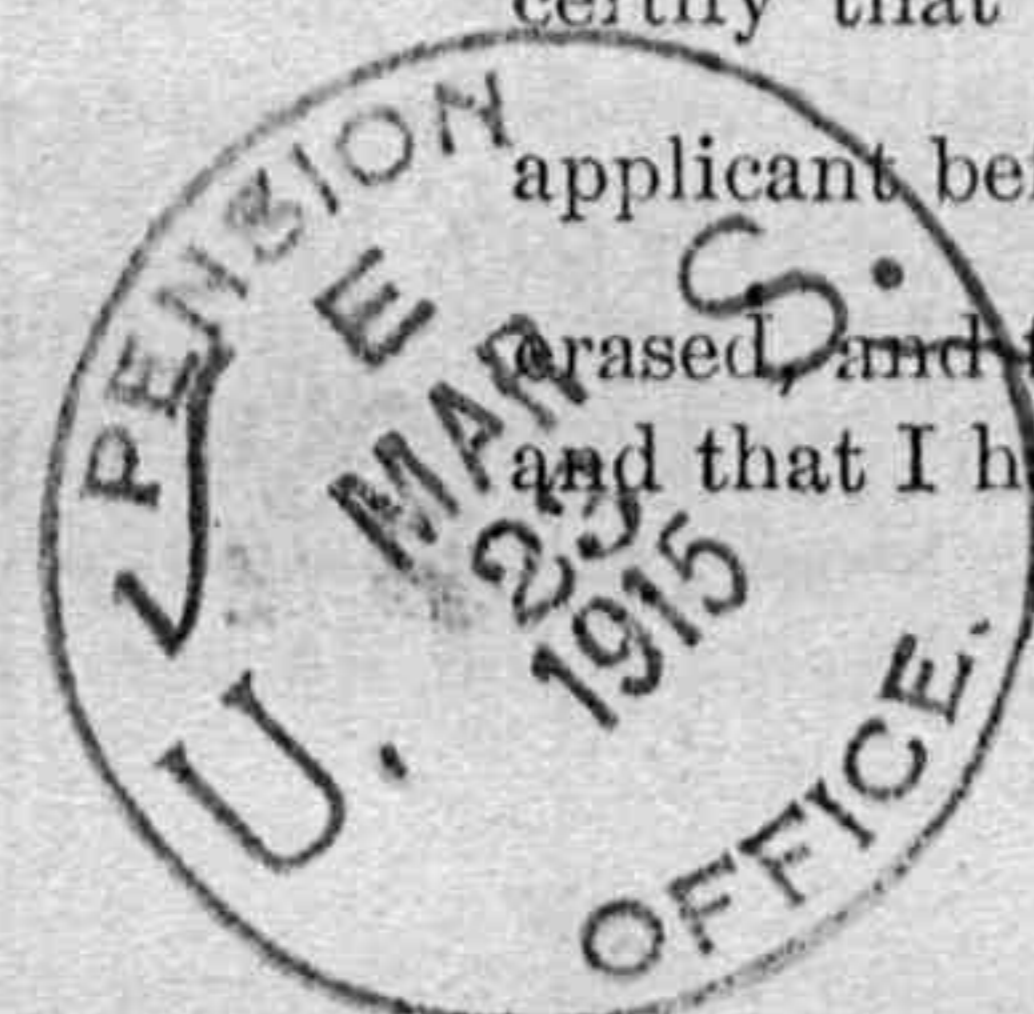
