That he was born in the year 1835, to prove this declaration he submits a paper reading as follows:

Maryland, Kent County, to wit; Pursuant to the directions of an act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at November session 1845, and I hereby certify that by the last will and testament of Catharine W. Wroth late of Kent County deceased, bearing date the 27 Decr. 1854, and duly proved and recorded in this office, it appears that a negro man, named Harry, alias, Harry Morell the negro here of is freed from slavery, and I further certify that it has been proved by satisfactory testimony that said Harry, alias Harry Morell is the identical negro freed as aforesaid. That said Harry, is 5 ft. 9 inches high, dark complexion, beabout 23 years old and was raised in Kent County. Harry has a scar on left cheek. In testimony hereof, I have hereunto subscribed my name and affixed my seal, this 16th day September, 1858.
