

DECLARATION FOR PENSION.

THE PENSION CERTIFICATE SHOULD NOT BE FORWARDED WITH THE APPLICATION.

State of Maryland, County of Kent, ss:

On this 13 day of December, A. D. 1913, personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace within and for the county and State aforesaid, Henry Worrell

who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is 78 years of age, and a resident of Chestertown, county of Kent, State of Maryland; and that he is the identical person

who was ENROLLED at Chestertown Sent Du Camp Belgium, under the name of Henry Worrell

in Leo D 7 Reg US Colored Volunteer Inftry on the 26 day of Sept, 1863, as a Private (Here state rank, and company and regiment in the Army, or vessels if in the Navy.)

in the service of the United States, in the Civil war, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Texas, on the 16 day of November, 1866 (State name of war, Civil or Mexican.)

That he also served as a Corporal. He is Described in (Here give a complete statement of all other services, if any.)

a Slave Certificate Which He Holds given Sept 16 = 1858 as being 23 years old and a Scar on his left cheek

That he was not employed in the military or naval service of the United States otherwise than as stated above. That his personal

eyes, Dark; color of hair, Dark; that his occupation was Laborer; that he

was born Kent County, 18, at Lyncher Station

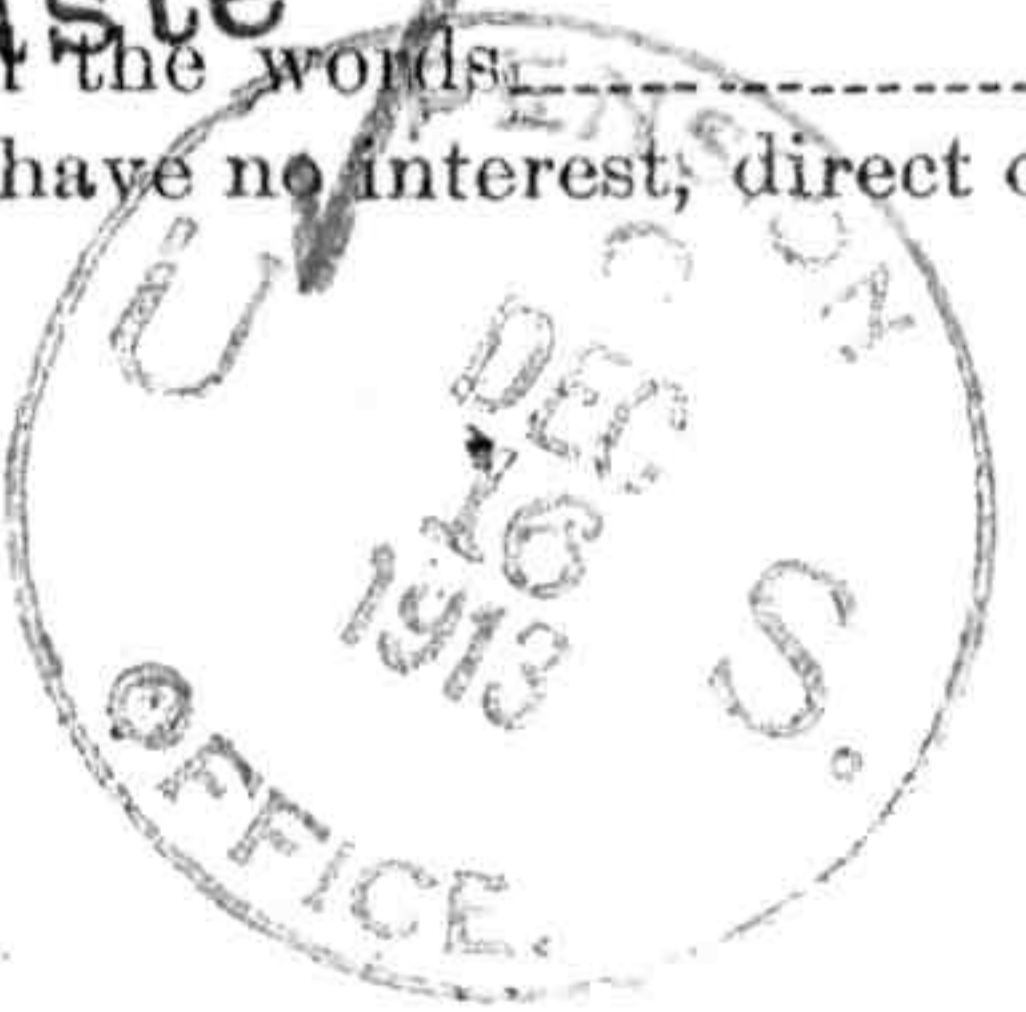
