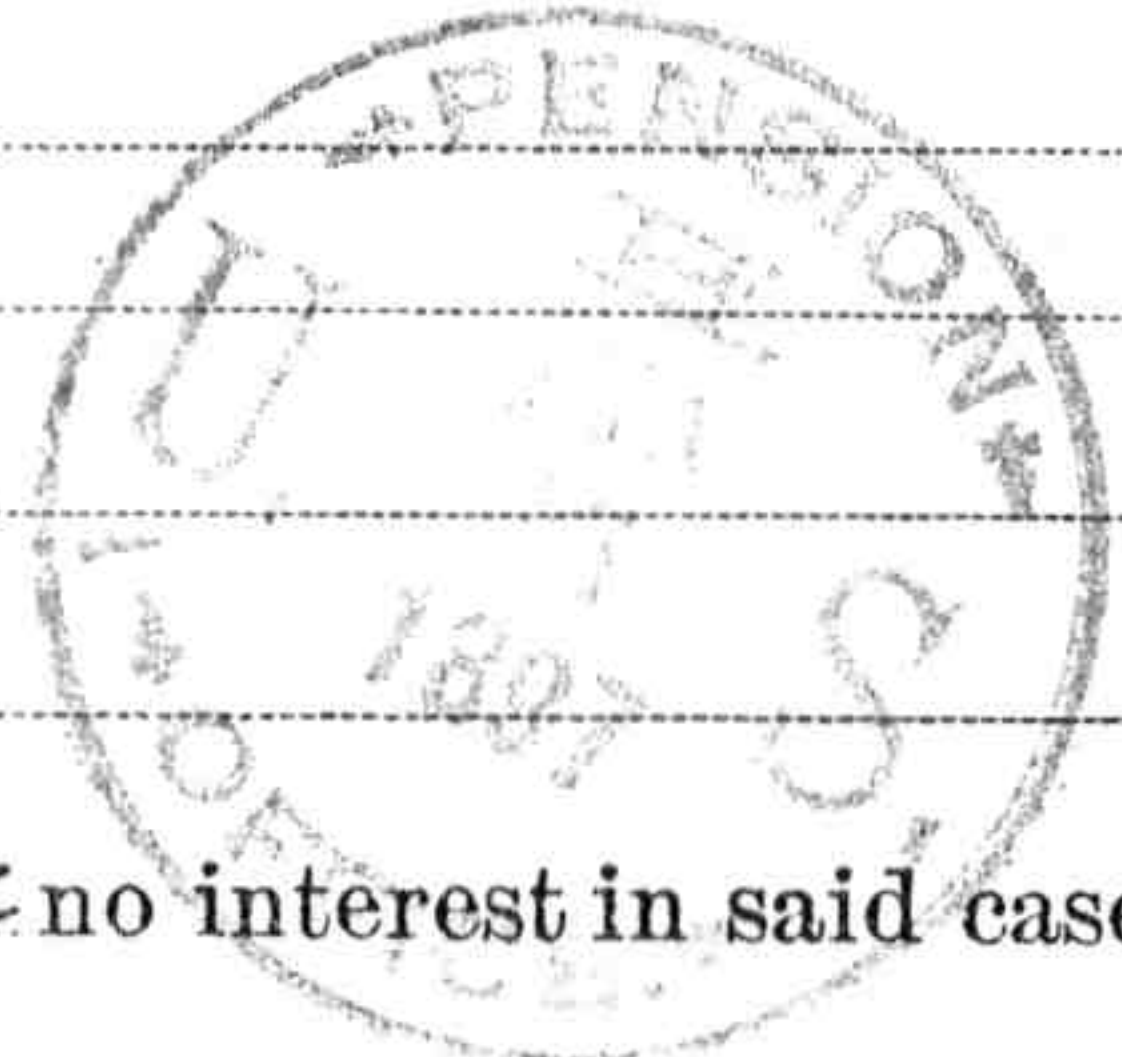

I was in the same Regiment with Thomas Carmichael he was our Commissary Sergeant and I drove one of the Commissary wagons I was present when he incurred injury of left ankle and know it was not the result of vicious habits it hapened on or about the 16<sup>th</sup> day of August 1864 at night near Fussells Mills directly after Battle at Fussells Mills marching in the dark he stepped into a deep rut and slipped his ankle out of place and was taken to camp in my wagon
