Here give a full description of the disabilities, in accordance with Book of Instructions.
Varicose veins of right leg long saphenous vein tortuous and slightly patulous but no rupture or pending rupture or bleeding. The patulousness is on anterior of right leg 5 in below right knee 3 x 4 inches but the enlarged tortuous condition extends all over the surface mentioned. The varicosity of left leg is less pronounced than the right. The varicosity is confined to long saphenous vein extending from inner side of leg and extend over anterior and inner side of left leg below left knee. The veins are apt patulous, bleeding rupture or pending rupture but is tortuous and enlarged but patulous as in right leg. Dis of heart and senility Hypertrophy is pronounced but no intermission, regurgitation, murmurs or valvular lesion. Apex of pulleg in 6th intercostal space and in median line. Area of cardiac dullness extended to cyanosis but does have turgidness head smothered and oppressed breathing upon exertion to dyspnoea but his hypertrophy in competition with his age is quite a factor in disabling him from or normal labor. He is much susceptible of vertigo that he claims as a separate disability is due to his heart disease. Injury to left ankle no marks scars or other evidence of injury to ankle. It was dislocated but he alleges numbness lack of feeling but there is nothing to show results of injury to ankle. Impaired vision He
