

DECLARATION FOR INVALID PENSION.

Act of June 27, 1890.

To be executed before any officer authorized to administer oaths for general purposes in city, or county where said officer resides. If such officer has a seal and uses it upon such paper, no certificate of a county clerk or prothonotary or clerk of a court shall be necessary; but when no seal is used by the officer before whom the declaration is executed, then a clerk of a court of record or a county or city clerk shall affix his official seal thereto, and shall certify to the signature and official character of said officer.

State of Maryland, County of Kent, ss:

ON THIS 27 day of March, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety-seven personally appeared before me, a Clerk of Circuit Court within and for the county and State aforesaid Oscar J. Crozier

aged 52 years, a resident of the Chestertown county of Kent State of Maryland, who, being duly sworn according to law

declares that he is the identical Oscar J. Crozier who was enrolled on the day of 1863, in Private Co "B"

54 "Regt. U. S. C. Troops Here state rank, company, and regiment in military service, or vessel, if in the Navy.

in the service of the United States in the War of the Rebellion, and served at least ninety days and was honorably discharged at Boston, Massachusetts on the

day of 1864 That he is now unable to earn a support by manual labor by reason of Slight effect in left eye received

in line of duty 20 Feb 1864, injury in back received in line of duty July 1864, Rheumatism

That said disabilities are not due to his vicious habits, and are to the best of his knowledge and belief of a permanent character; that he has never applied for pension under Certificate No. that he is a pensioner under Certificate No.

If a pensioner, the certificate number only need be given; if not, give the number of the former application, if one was made. That he has not been employed in the Military or Naval service otherwise than as stated above.

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension-roll of the United States under the provisions of the Act of June 27, 1890.

He hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation, Geo. W. F. Vernon 313 St. Paul Street, of Baltimore State of Maryland, his true and lawful attorney to prosecute his claim, and to receive therefor a fee of ten dollars; that his post-office address is Chestertown county of Kent, State of Maryland.
