

ACT OF FEBRUARY 6, 1907.

DECLARATION FOR PENSION.

THE PENSION CERTIFICATE SHOULD NOT BE FORWARDED WITH THE APPLICATION.

On this 30 day of October, A. D. one thousand nine hundred and nine, personally appeared before me, a Justice of the Peace within and for the county and State aforesaid, Oscar J. Crozier, who, being duly sworn according to law, declares that he is 62 years of age, and a resident of Chester town county of Kent, State of Maryland; and that he is the identical person who was ENROLLED at Readville Massachusetts under the name of Oscar J. Crozier, on the April day of 1863, as a musician, in Co B 54 Reg Massachusetts Caval

ry Infantry, String Brigade Second Div 10 Corps in the service of the United States, in the Civil war, and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at Boston, on the day of , 18 .

That he also served at Garrison Duty in South Carolina until August 20 1865 then ordered to Boston paid and discharged.

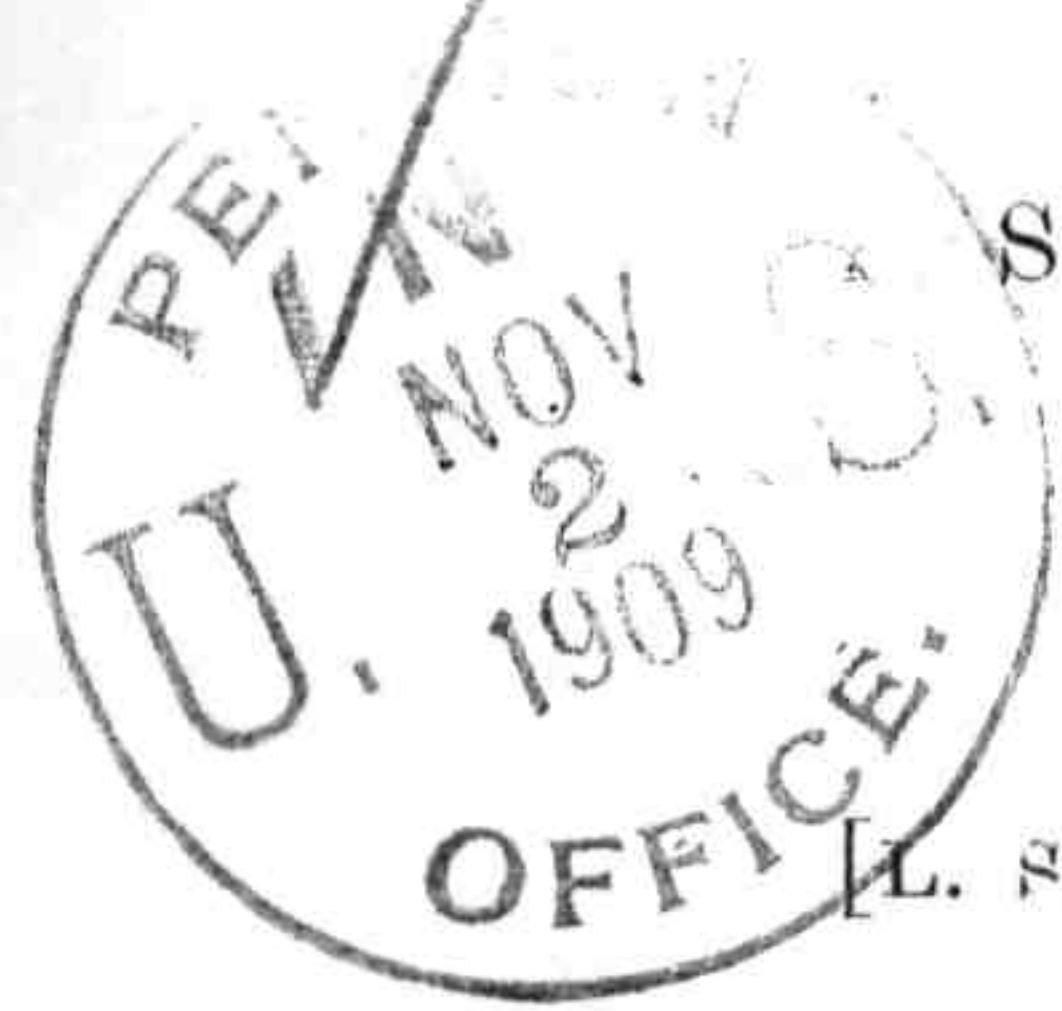
That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the provisions of the act of February 6, 1907.
