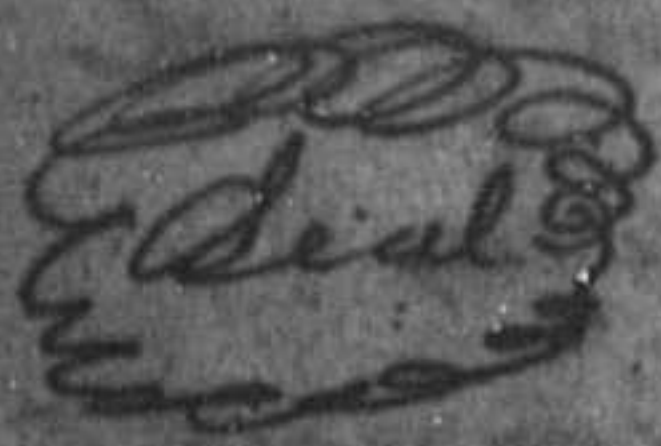

I hereby certify that a certain negro woman named Minta now about 25 years old of light complexion and without any scars, being 4 feet 11 1/2 inches high, was manumitted & set free by the last will & testament of a certain Margaret Chambers dated August 2<sup>d</sup> 1824 and admitted to probate in my office Nov. 28<sup>th</sup> 1833, her freedom to commence at the age of twenty five years, her person I identified by the evidence of a certain Richard Carter who also testifies to her age.

I hereby certify that a certain mulatto woman now about twenty ~~eight~~ <sup>thirty</sup> years old five feet five inches high, very light complexion and has two scars on the right side of her face, was manumitted and set free by the last will & testament of a certain Margaret Lowry dated the 25<sup>th</sup> May 1825 and admitted to probate in my office on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of March 1827. Her freedom to commence when she is twenty eight years old - her person I identified by the evidence of a certain John Cook.
