Calvert County State of Maryland, are illegally re-
strained of their liberty and are held in custody
by one Richard Roberts residing in the County of
Calvert, near Huntingtown in the State aforesaid,
by virtue of certain alleged indentures of Ap-
prenticeship made without the consent of the
Petitioners' lawful guardian or guardians in
contravention of the Constitution and laws of
the United States

Your Petitioners therefore pray ^{that} your
Honor will order the issue of the writ of Habeas
Corpus in their behalf directed to the said Richard
Roberts commanding him to produce before this
Honorable Court ^{upon a day in said writ to be named} the bodies of the said Dinah Gar-
ry, Wesley Garry and Maria Clark with the date
and cause of their capture and detention and to
show cause if any he has why your petitioners
should not be discharged from their said
unlawful custody and detention & as in
duty bound &c.
