and detention of the said John C Logie, and that you  
then and there do submit to and receive whatsoever the said  
Judge shall determine upon concerning you in this behalf  
according to law, and have you then and there this writ.

Witness the Honorable Upton S Heath Judge of the said  
District Court the first Tuesday in December in the year  
of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and fifty six.
