that you certify and make known the
day and cause of the capture and detention
of the said Philip Richardson, and that
you then and there do submit to and
~~or~~ receive what so ever the said Judge
shall determine upon concerning you
in this behalf, according to Law, and
have you then and there this writ -
Witness the Honorable Elias Glenn
Judge of our said District Court the
fourth day of August Eighteen hundred
and twenty eight

Philip Richardson has been duly

arrested in a private ^{prayer} suit for
thirty-two Dollars, and is now
kept in confinement in the Jail

of Baltimore County thereof -

Wherefore your Petitioner
prays that a writ of Habeas Corpus
may issue out in this behalf

and the said Richard was brought
before your Honor and that
he be released from his illegal
imprisonment and be restored
the service of the United States
