# Declaration for Invalid Pension.

By a New Law, this may be Executed before any Officer Authorized to Administer Oaths. If Executed before an Officer who has NO SEAL, his Official Character Must be Certified ON THE BACK HEREOF.

State of Maryland, County of Howard SS:

ON THIS 21<sup>st</sup> day of March, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and ninety-two

personally appeared before me, a Notary Public, duly authorized to administer oaths within and for the County and State aforesaid.

George Preston aged 60 years, a resident of the City of Beltsville, County of Baltimore State of Maryland, who, being duly Sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical

person who was enrolled on 11<sup>th</sup> March, 1864, in Company F, Regiment 30<sup>th</sup> 100<sup>th</sup> Vols

in the War of the Rebellion, and served at least ninety days, and was honorably discharged at Roanoke Island on the December day of 1865. That he

is now unable to earn a support by reason of Rheumatism and Injuries [Here name the diseases or injuries from which disabled.]

from a hand

That he has not been employed in the military or naval service otherwise than as stated above. [If other service rendered erase not and state what the service was, whether prior or subsequent to that stated above, and the dates at which it began and ended.]

That said disabilities are not due to his vicious habits, and are to the best of his knowledge and belief permanent. That [If a pensioner, the certificate number only]

No. need be given, if not, give the number of the former application, if one was made.]

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the pension roll of the United States under the provisions of the act of June 27, 1890.

He hereby appoints **JAMES H. SPALDING**, of Washington, D. C., his true and lawful attorney, to prosecute his claim, and for and in consideration of services done and to be done in the premises, hereby agrees to allow said attorney a fee of ten dollars, which shall include all amounts to be paid for any services in the furtherance of said claim under the act of June 27, 1890, and said fee shall not be demanded by or payable to said attorney, in whole or in part, except in case of the granting of a pension by the Commissioner of Pensions under the act of June 27, 1890, and that the same shall be paid them in in accordance with the provisions of Section 4 of said Act and other laws pertaining thereto.
