

Declaration for the Increase of an Invalid Pension.

Acts of June 27, 1890, and May 9, 1900.

duly sworn according to law, declares that he is the identical George Preston

who was ENROLLED on the day of 18, in Co. F,

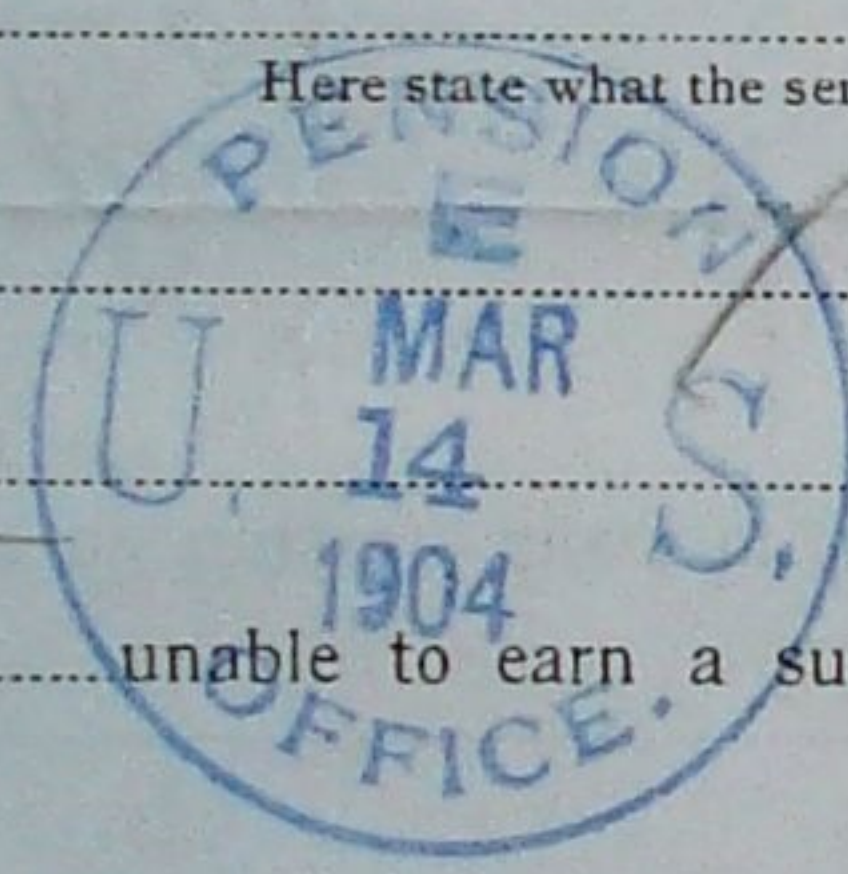
30th Regiment United States Colored Volunteer Infantry

(a Private) in the service of the United States in the War of the Rebellion, and served at least Ninety Days,

and was HONORABLY DISCHARGED at, on the day of

18. That he has not been employed in the Military or Naval service otherwise

than as stated above



That he is totally unable to earn a support by manual labor by reason of his advanced age

& Since last medical examination his disability has greatly increased.

That said disabilities are not due to vicious habits, and are, to the best of his knowledge and belief, of a permanent character.

That he is a pensioner under Certificate No. 999 545, at the monthly rate of Six dollars.

That he makes this declaration for the purpose of being placed on the Pension-Roll of the United States, under the provisions of the ACT OF JUNE 27, 1890, AND UNDER ACT OF MAY 9, 1900, AT A LARGER RATE THAN HE NOW RECEIVES.

That he hereby appoints, with full power of substitution and revocation—

HARVEY SPALDING & SONS, of Washington, D. C.,

his true and lawful attorneys to prosecute his claim, and to receive therefor the legal fee.
