It appears from the records of this office that Joseph Parker was enlisted on the 8th day of May, 1867, at Phila. Pa., and was assigned to Troop "K," 10th Regiment of U.S. Cav. Muster-roll June 30, 72, shows him Discharged May 8, 72, by expiration of service, a sergt.

Enlisted again July 27, 72, and assigned to Troop "D," 10th Cavalry; transferred Nov. 19, 72, to Troop "K," same Regt., appointed Saddler Sergt, and transferred to the Regt. Non-Com. Staff, March 11, 73, and promoted to Sergt. Major, 10th Cavalry, April 3, 73.

Muster-roll of the Regt. Non-Com. Staff, 10th Cavalry, for Aug. 31, 77, shows him Discharged July 22, 77, by expiration of service, a Sergt. Major.

Reenlisted July 22, 77, in same organization. Muster-roll for Jan. + Feby, 1882, shows him, Died Jan. 20, 82, of Heart Disease, found dead in his room, at Fort Couch, Texas, a sergt. Major.
