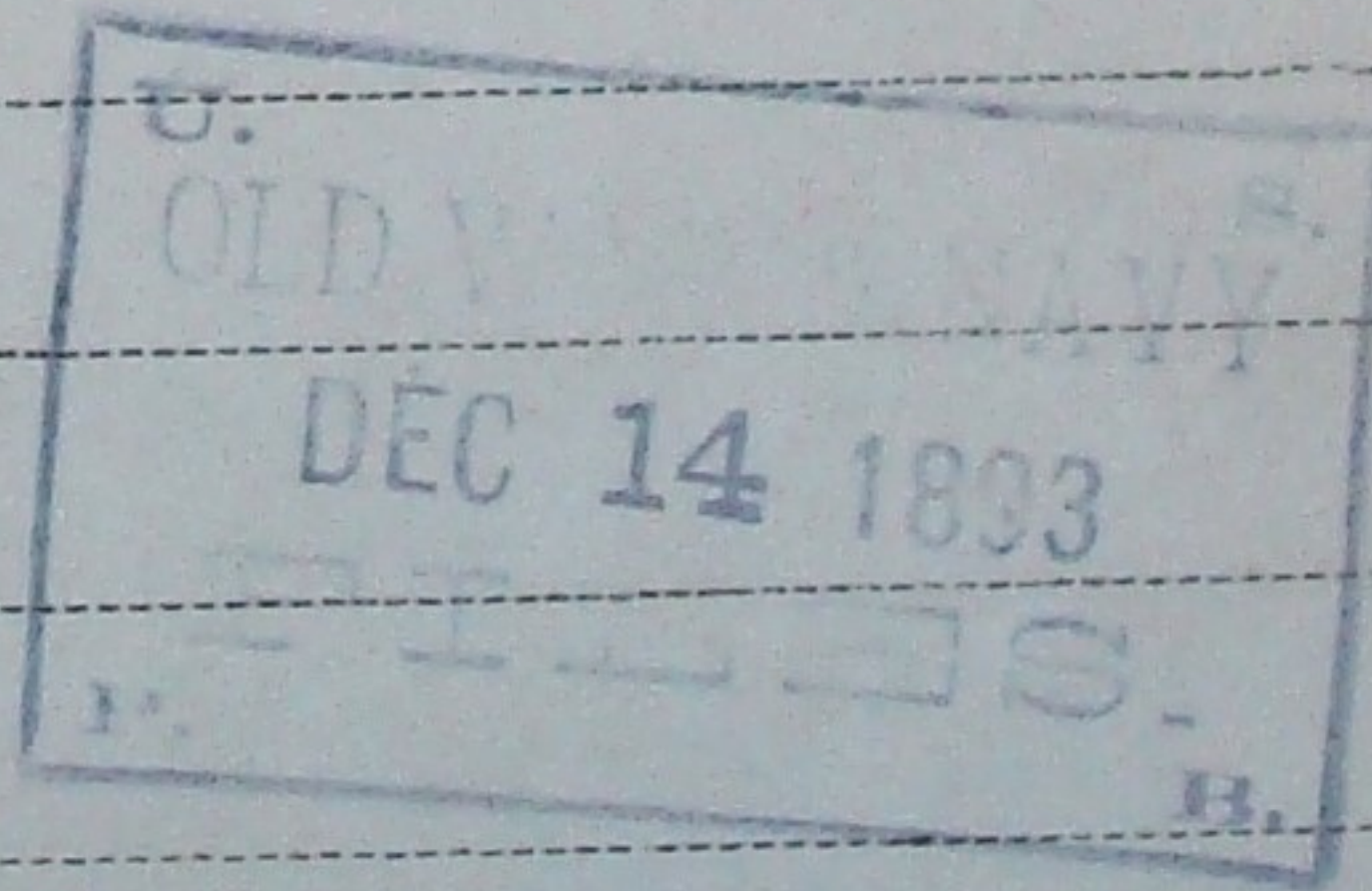


Washington, D. C., Dec 11, 1893.
