Your inquiry of April 7, 1887, in Pension Claim No. 590178, is herewith returned, with the following information:

Samuel Johnson drafted was enrolled on the 28th day of June, 1864, at Baltimore Md, as a private rec in Co. C, 39th Regiment of U. S. Colored Troops, to serve 3 years.

He is reported on Muster Roll for July & Aug. 64. Present for duty: Sept. & Oct. 64 absent "Detached for extra guard & since Sept 1."; Nov & Dec 64 present for duty. "Returned to Co Dec 30/64"; Jan & Feb and March & April 65 present "on detached serv. Div Pioneer since Feb 1st"; May & June 65, absent "Sick in hosp. since June 25, 65"; July & Aug and Sept & Oct 65. Present for duty.

He was mustered out of service, with Co. December 4, 1865, at Wilmington, N. C. Co. Mg. Reports covering same by Lt. W. S. show him June 26th 65, from 2 in G. to Ab. Sick; July 28th 65, from "about to 2 in G."; Aug. 5-65, from 5 in G. to Hospital at New Berne, N. C., "17" duty; 19th 8 in G. to Ab. Sick. Nature of sickness or date ret'd. to duty in most of the above entries not stated.
