

so because we were afraid if captured we would be returned to our former masters - I am sure that John Corner served in my Co, & kept under the assumed name of Robt Seddeman - and that after discharge he resumed the name of John Corner.

He was of good health at enlistment although he was "raw boned" and very thin at all times - I never knew of him being sick injured or wounded - in service I have heard him complain of head aches & local troubles in service but nothing serious - I think he attended sick call - got a little quinine & that's about all - he was not in hospital - I think he was excused once from duty cant say what was the matter with him - I knew nothing of him after discharge as he lived here in Balto - & I ~~lived~~ lived in Howard Co - I saw him ~~at~~ some few times after the war he was not then sick - I cant say what years I saw him - I made affidavit for Court I cant say what I swore to.

I have heard you read affidavit its not true, my statement to you is correct.

I have understood your question & my answers have been properly recorded
